

Only time will disclose the exact fate of the Fourth Republic, with its unbroken chain of fragile governments, as result of the old soldier's move.

Whether genuine civil war will ensue would
sppear to depend upon how violently the extremists of the left—the Communists—react

to de Gaulle's attempt to impose a sadly need-du unity and purpose upon the country. The Reds' strike indicates at least that their re-sponse will not be mild.

It is but a short time since de Gaulle visited Paris to let! the French people that he wied ity to take the reins only if there were at strong popular demand for his leadership, and only if it could be done by legal proce-ture. significantly, in his announcement that he

significantly, in his announcement that he is forming a new government he stressed that he had begun "legal procedures" to that end, once more illustrating, his insistence upon avoiding extra-legal or revolutionary means. —Turthermore, he used the word "republican" to emphasize that he has no intention of setting up a dictatorship as a way of at-tacking France's bitter problems in Algeria

tacking prance's bitter problems in Algeria and elsewhere.

Revolution or not, it is plain that if de Gaulis succeeds in this action, he will have brought France to a great turning point. No one imagines that the Fourth Republic will ever be restored to the status, however feeble, that it has had since World war II.

Obviously de Gaulie has persuaded himself that the demand for his help exists unmistakeably among his countrymen. Again, time will show whether or not that is true.

Certain it is that out of this terrible ordeal of the French there' had to come a big move, that the crisis had to have a climax. General de Gaulie has produced that climax.






