

They are members of congress, the newspaper corps- and businessmen in a jam with a regulatory segment.

Whenever a pollitican or an industrialist has a case before any of those agencies, he generally attempts to obtain a letter or telephonic intercession from his sentor or representative. As Adams contends in the Gold-fine matter, this political reinforcement fray not have any effect on the eventual decision. Washington background who does not think differently.

And, of course, a telephone call from the White House carries far more weight than one from a member of congress.

Reporters often resort to this kind of tactic. Time and again when an official or a department refuses to give information, a reporter simply asks a congressman to request the data. In most instances, his secretary is able to pry out the required news by a mere phone call.

Frequently, they must spend several days
at the capital, incurring heavy hotel expenditures, before they can get in to see an examimer or minor official. But a White House

Adams may believe he did not in fact try to exercise any influence in behalf of his friend Bernard Goldine, and that no federal agency responded with special favor. He also may believe he at no time allowed Avors done by Goldine for him to affect his scrupulous handling of the government's affairs.

But it is not enough that a man shall so persuade himself. It is not enough that he believes he resisted and can always resist the aubte influences of friendship.

What is enough is that everyone shall accept him as above suspicion. And this is possible only if he divests himself or all gifting thing, hospitality - taking entanglements with friends, and takes not the smallest action in their behalf with any government official or agency. Was imprudent to deal even routinely with a tederal gapany in Goldfine's behalf. He must be understand he was equally unwhe in melanties in friendship on the easy-going basis of an ordinary citizen. There are no ordinary citizens in the White House.




