

Too Much,' Says President, 'etoores Funds Measure

WASHINGTON, Aug. 4 (UPI)—President Eisenhower, in his first action since taking office, today vetoed a \$600 million appropriations bill because congress added to the money request about 500 million dollars for the civil service. The President advised congress that the measure was "too much" and that there was "no sound justification" for the extra money.

It was Eisenhower's first veto of an appropriation bill. The vetoed measure carried funds for the current fiscal year and the next year.

The agencies concerned will be asked to estimate the remainder of this month under an emergency law enacted earlier to cover departmental needs until the next session of congress.

He said that he reluctantly vetoed the measure because it contained "many important amendments." But he did not feel that the extra money was "too much" and that it was "not sound" to add it to the 500 million dollar request.

U.S. Aids Troops, Tanks for Garrison Of Ineassy Lebanon

BEIRUT, Lebanon, Aug. 4 (AP)—The United States swelled its armed force in Lebanon to more than 10,000 men over the week-end. The Middle East battleground enjoyed a respite from major shooting but the politicians began bickering over who should represent Lebanon at a summit conference.

Both tanks and American military equipment were on the way although the Lebanese rebellion has settled into an uneasy truce since the election of Gen. Hafez el-Helou as president.

Rebel leader Kamel Jumblatt reported shattering his 2,000-man private army in the mountains southeast of Beirut. But the rebel leaders in Tripoli and Beirut kept their units intact.

However, Saeb Salam, the rebel chief in Beirut, and other rebel leaders are expected to meet in Amman, Jordan, to discuss the situation.

Officials Sure Missiles Arms Match Russia

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla., Aug. 4 (UPI)—Submarine missile men were confident today that the United States has matched Russia's new class of intercontinental ballistic missile capable of carrying a nuclear warhead.

Their belief was expected to be confirmed in the next few weeks.

Sputnik sources over the week-end in the wake of the first successful launch of a fully-powered Atlas missile by Russian engineers, technicians and other missile men that this country now counts on the assured capability of hitting any other continent with hydrogen warheads.

Another source described the test as a "major breakthrough" in the missile race with Russia.

Although Saturday's test flight covered only 2,300 miles, sources said the project aimed the Atlas could be blasted 6,200 miles simply by adding more fuel.

Missouri River Dam Rituals Are Marred by Prairie Fire

PIERRE, S. D., Aug. 4 (UPI)—Bachelors broke the back of the intergrade Missouri river yesterday but the celebrating was cut short by a raging prairie fire.

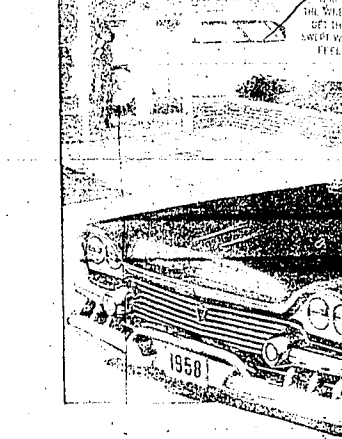

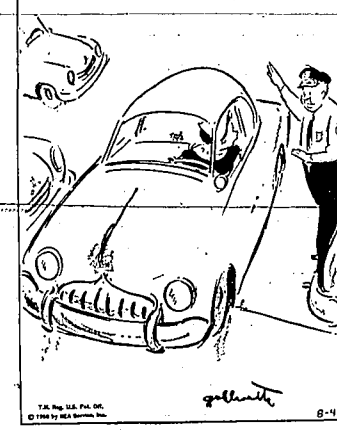

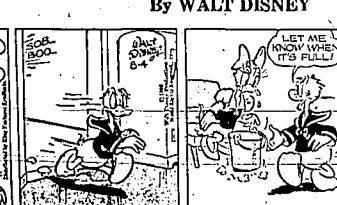

Fluorspar Spotlighted as One Of Vital Minerals in Aid Plan

WASHINGTON, Aug. 4 (Special)—Efforts to aid the assistance of the industry in fluorine are being spotlighted as one of the five most vital non-ferrous minerals in the U. S. Subsidies for lead, zinc, tungsten and fluorine, and other aid for long way off. Evolution of a workable engine for static ground, though KIVI-A, a laboratory reactor, is to be put into fluorescent operation this fall in Nevada.

For three generations of missiles, reaching ahead for a decade, chemical fuels are expected to power U. S. rockets—Atlas-missiles are to be operational in a year and a half, Titan, and then Minuteman—a solid fuel missile now in the development stage, all largely on paper. Even a workable nuclear rocket won't, end fluorine's usefulness. Cost alone may dictate much use of chemical fuels, rather than atomic materials, where cost for a single flight could reach 150 million dollars for fuel alone.

Chief reason for delays in setting fluorine-hydrazine systems into operation is the instability of the two materials. Fluorine, a yellowish, poisonous element, is highly corrosive. It is the most active non-metallic substance, combining voraciously with most other elements, raising severe problems in making tanks, fuel lines, valves and the other intricate, delicate parts of a missile, able to hold the fluorine without disintegrating. Use of at least some fluorine in the Apollo program indicates that this problem is slowly being overcome.

One measure of the importance of fluorine derivatives is their listing among verboten shipments to communist bloc countries. Fluorine is specified as a rocket fuel, and is on the prohibited munitions list. Another less-potent "exotic" fuel, boron, is similarly restricted.

With the U. S. producing 90 percent of the world's boron, illegal exporting is lucrative. Boron violations were the most numerous uncovered in 1955-57. Fluorine violations are rare, largely because the pure gas is almost impossible to transport long distances. Also, foreign production is available to Soviet rocket engineers.

The proposed aid to fluorine producers is estimated to cost \$270,000 annually. The secretary of the interior would be authorized to pay the difference between actual market price and \$53 per short ton to producers, with maximum payments at \$13 per ton. Annual production for payments would be limited to 180,000 tons.

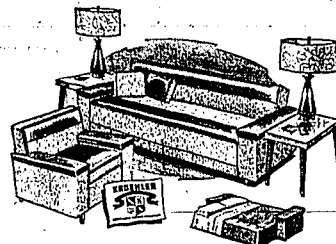
