Prevention and control of accidental poisoning, "the major death threat to children of this community," was stressed Saturday by the Junior Chamber of Commerce, preparing to embark upon campaign to prevent poisoning tragedies.

"Every 24 hours, one child in the United States dies as a result of ignorance, carelessness and ready access to harmful drugs and poisons," declared Monte Kuka, project chairman.

"More children die from accidental poisoning than from polio, diphtheria, whooping cough, scarlet fever, measles, German measles or any of the streptococcal infections," he asserted.

Each 24 hours, more than 150 children are poisoned through their own curiosity which causes them to gulp aspirin, sleeping pills, kerosene, floor polish, rubber cement, kitchen detergents, cosmetics and

### Claiming Drop-in Living Cost Good Way to Start Argument

NEW YORK, Sept. 22 (AP)—If the understanding that arises from over-emphasizing the importance of a drop in the American housewife's cost of living has gone down.

The bureau of labor statistics says this has just happened to its consumer price index for the first time in two years.

It says the drop came in the price of foods, which carry 30 per cent of the weight of the index. A housewife has no trouble telling her husband of a "tumbler" of foods whose prices haven't gone down at all, and some whose prices have just gone up.
