First Aid Instructors Take Course

Most of Leaves Removed From Streets of Twin Falls Used by Gardeners, Farmers

The Twin Falls street department is currently in the midst of its annual leaf removal project, trucking them to 'Individuals who use leaves for garden and field fertilizer.

Depending upon the weather, the project will take 12 men operating six trucks, one power loader, and one power aweeper about two weeks. About 48 truckloads are hauled a day.

Work began in the old townsite and will progress through the "prestdent" and "tree" streets, ending with spot pickups on the remaining

After residents have raked leaves into the gutter the destination of the leaves vary. Some loads are transported to garden owners within the city, other loads are carried to nearby farms. A rich fertilizer, leaves

Twin Falls residents can order the leaves simply by phoning the city hall and leaving their name and address and the number of truck-

loads desired.

Leaves hauled within the city limits are free. The city charges nearby farmers 25 cents per mile for leaves hauled outside the city limits.

According to J. H. Latimore, Twin Falls city manager, the city tries to keep the haule short, within a

Latimore estimates 75 per cent of the leaves are hailed within the city limits. "We try to keep our hauls as short as possible, so our expenses, are less," he explains. He said the 15-cent charge just pays for equipment expense."


