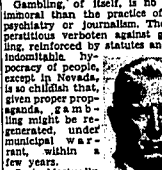

VALPARAISO, Ind., Dec. 19 (UP)—Will Ponder's cow lay dead again. Ponder was sure the 12-year-old Holstein named Miltie died twice yesterday from what a veterinarian had earlier diagnosed as pleurisy pneumonia. "She was dead as dead can be," the 77-year-old farmer said. "Her head was covered with snow, and she was stretched out in the barnyard, stiff as a brick." Slippery roads kept the rendering plant truck from reaching the farm, so Ponder just left Miltie lying in the barnyard. Tuesday morning he walked out, and there was Miltie standing up and belching. Ponder recovered from his shock and watched her gulp down three gallons of milk and

several loaves of bread. The veterinarian said she may have been in a deep coma. But the remarkable recovery was only temporary. Miltie was lying in the barnyard again Wednesday—looking just as dead as the first time. This time Ponder buried her before she changed her mind again.

### Chinese Boast Of Communes' Prowess Told

TOKYO, Dec. 19 (UP)—Peiping radio boasted yesterday that the dramatic commune system has swept up 90 per cent of the peasants in the drive to make red China a world industrial giant. And now the drive is on to extend the communes to all cities and towns. Ignoring reports abroad of widespread peasant resistance and chaos high in the council of the Chinese communist party itself, Peiping radio declared: "A new social organization has appeared fresh as the morning sun above the broad horizon of east Asia."

Peiping was quoting from a resolution approved by the party central committee at Wuchang Dec. 10—the same meeting that announced Mao Tse-tung's forthcoming retirement as president. It took 4 hours, 20 minutes to broadcast the 15,000-word resolution. Reports from the Chinese nationalists underground have said seething unrest over the commune system—which uproots families and places them in labor battalions—led to the decision to replace Mao as chief of the government.

"New 15 Discussed" But this appears largely discounted in view of the party's decision to press forward until the commune system engulfed every city and rural area in China. Indeed, the committee description of the communes as "fresh as the morning sun" might well have been written by Mao, who considers himself something of a poet. Peiping radio said since the first communes appeared last summer the peasants had reorganized themselves into "over 26,000 communes." This embraced more than 120 million households "or more than 99 per cent of all the peasant households of various nationalities in China," the broadcast said. Now the emphasis will be on the

city communes. The resolution disclosed conflicts high in the party, not over the merits of the commune system but over the speed with which it is heading China from socialism to complete communism. As a result of misunderstanding some party members think "they can dispense with the Socialist principle of distribution according to work and adopt the communist principle of distribution according to needs," the resolution said. But the resolution said this misunderstanding must be cleared up because "the socialist system will have to continue for a very long time."
