



"POLITICAL COWARDS"

The 35th Idaho legislature is over, an so far as we are concerned it will go down in history as a weak sister.

in history as a weak sister.

From all we have read since the session adjourned, the Idaho State Journal at Pocatello-came the closest to describing the general assembly just ended. The meat of its tello-came the closest to describing the gen-eral assembly just ended. The mest of its editorial comment was expressed in the fol-lowing sentence: "The Idaho legislature largely failed in its responsibility to the people of the state because most of the members were political cowards."

cowards."

While-the-Pocatello-newspaper was referring particularly to the legislature's cowardice in not adopting a sales tax which that only been postponed and "is inevitably the state's least paints solution to the revenue problem," there were other ways in which the legislature lacked the courage to measure up to its responsibilities.

Although there has been a serious need in Idaho for drastic action to curb the red-ord-breaking toil of death and destruction on our highways, the legislature all but closed its eyes to the course of action recommended by Governor Smylle.

Although 280 people lost their lives on Idaho's highways last year—an all-time high—the legislature would not face up to the fact, for instance, that the minimum driving age in Idaho should be raised from it to 18 years, as was emphasized by the governor.

It made no difference to the legislature that Idaho is one of the few states in the nation permitting 14- and 15-year-olds to drive cars, nor that statistics from a survey of the Kellogy high school, showing how education is impaired by such youth-ful driving, are being quoted throughout the nation to Idahos discredit.

The legislature's failure to correct this situation was another example of political cowardice—fear of incurring rural opposition from those farmers who want their 14- and 15-year-old sons and daughters-to
