Trainmen to Seek Boosts In Their Pay

CLEVELAND, April 21 (AP)—A 14 per cent pay increase will be sought by the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen for its nearly 200,000 members in negotiations on a new contract this year.

This was announced yesterday by W. P. Kennedy, brotherhood president, who said notices of the union's demands are being sent to the nation's railroads. He said the demands are based on recommendations of the brotherhood's wages-rules committee and have been adopted by the union's general membership association.

The bill, which represents brakemen, conductors, firemen and shifting car employees, also is asking that the cost-of-living bonus be added to the basic rates before the 14 per cent boost is computed. The bonus, at present 13 cents an hour, is based on the rise or fall of the cost-of-living index.
