### Model Capsule Is Due Test in July

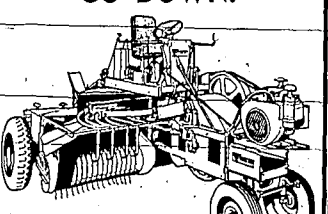
