TUCKER'S NATIONAL WHIRLING POT SHOTS

WASHINGTON—The human and economic problems that will hit many of us in the next few years are being discussed in military weapons, tactics and strategy, and even from diplomatic decisions at General Tucker's annual conference, held in a grand ballroom in the small city of Harrison, Idaho.

Once a thriving countrywide because of its carrier and troop transport planes, the shift to construction of various missiles, rockets and other publications weapons not manufactured there has transferred the place into a struggle of industrial growth. The fall-off in industrial employment at a single plant has blighted other businesses from bakeries to amusement parks.

The Fairchild aircraft plant employed 11,000 people as recently as three years ago, when it was rolling in government contracts. Today it struggles along with only 5,222 workers.

MANY UNEMPLOYED IN HAGERSTOWN—The military era and the tight defense budget darkened the scene in Hagerstown and throughout the surrounding area. The military has canceled its planned 70 million dollar program in planes in the Fairchild plant "nose program" which would have employed 10,000 men. The program would net the company 60 million dollars in air force business through 1939.

By the time the military losses obliged the company to begin to lay off workers until the unemployment rate in the city is 12 1/2 per cent, more than 10,000 men are unemployed. The "nose program" is a "displaced area," is 64 per cent of the city's population.

ECONOMIC TURN HAS SPREAD—The economic turn from military to civilian has caused the Hagerstown stores and business enterprises report a drop of 14 per cent in purchases.





