This week, Robert Olson, public health biologist, and Harland Formo, state department of public health engineer, took additional samples of water from Rock creek for bacteriological analysis.

While making their check-up, Olson and ormo reminded the people of this comunity of several alarming facts which alady have been established.

Two and one-half to three million gal-lons of raw sewage, domestic and industrial, are being dumped into Rock crock every day, according to their findings, and some of the samples have shown "sewage" bac-teria counts of two and one-half million in

teria counts of two and one-man inition in six ounces.

This amount of bacterial contamination, they say, constitutes a definite health haz and to anyone coming in contact with Rock recek water. Even the handling of fish from Rock creek, these health authorities warned, presents a certain health hazard. 


