Rupert Plant Aide Talks at Burley Parley

BURLEY, May 17—Matty Heasler, assistant manager in the chemical division of the Burley Chamber of Commerce at its Monday luncheon at the County Hotel.

He stressed the alcohol produced in this plant would be for industrial use. He said some of the equipment of the plant is in Burley waiting to be installed.

He explained that the area of the potato, called scab, which is very high in nutrition for livestock, it is as valuable as a good mash for cattle. Holmes said the water is brought in from sealed wells at a 60-foot level with a temperature of 61 degrees and is cooled in reservoirs.

McLemore Notes Changes in Hirohito's Life Since War

It isn't often that I think of the Emperor of Japan. There are too many miles between us, too much disparity in Japan.

Hirohito writes poetry, studies fish and fiddle, white horses, I play pool, long musk-rata and wouldn't trust myself on a motorcycle - go - round horse.

Too, he's royal and the best my family can do in the way of a coat of arms is a - whether or not - participant on a field of unspiced cotton, with two bound dogs couchant.

But I did think of the Emperor of Japan yesterday. Quite a bit. My thoughts went East when I read of how he and the Empress would meet President Eisenhower at the airport when he arrives in Tokyo - a visit and of the ride the Emperor and the President would take through the streets in an open car.

It's a wonder that Hirohito has not lost his mind trying to keep up with the changes that he has had to put up with since V-J day. It's been better than a charade on a plaid shirt.

One day he was as remote as the sun, from which mighty body he is said to have descended. The next he all but had a nickname and was expected to throw a wacky feast alongside the imperial palace most.

The ride in an open car with a commoner - seen if that commoner happens to be the President of the U. S. - is another "first" for Hirohito. So is going to the airport to meet a visitor.

He's probably accustomed to "firsts" by now - or just about. Remember when he had to leave the palace and say a call on General MacArthur shortly after the war's end? I do, because a long discussion went on before the visit as to whether General MacArthur would put out on a tie to meet the emperor, or stick to his usual open - at - the - throat shirt. The General played it with no tie, and with combs.

To feel badly about Hirohito having to come down suddenly to the level of the common man? If I hadn't had the fortune to meet his daughter when I was in Tokyo not too long after the war.

A charming woman, she was taking English lessons from a

friend of mine, Nancy Echols, wife of Col. Paul Echols of MacArthur's staff. We had a long chat on the Echols front porch, and she told me, among other things, how delighted her father was with the chance to be a human being, not a god.

She told me that for the first time in his life he was using the telephone like everyone else, and that she wonders he made hundreds of calls a day over what was to him a new-fangled device.

The emperor was driving a car, too, his daughter said, although he confined - his - driving to private roads inside the palace grounds. And I got the impression that the emperor was having as much fun with his car as a teenager with his first jalopy.

The daughter told me - rather she showed me - one of the few things that her father had allowed her to keep when the royal family, along with all the other Japanese, continued personal belongings to the war effort.

It was a ring of gold an emerald. A New York Yankee ring it had been given to her by Babe Ruth, when the Babe and the Yanks were on a barnstorming tour of Japan.

The daughter said her father knew how much she cherished the ring, and didn't insist she give it up.

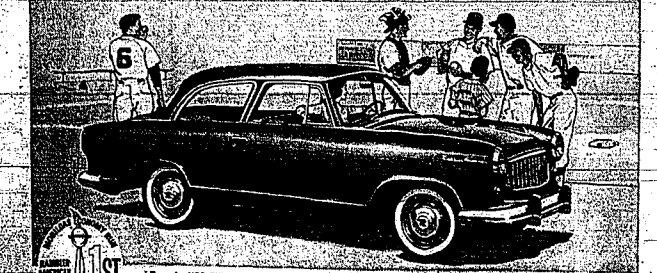
