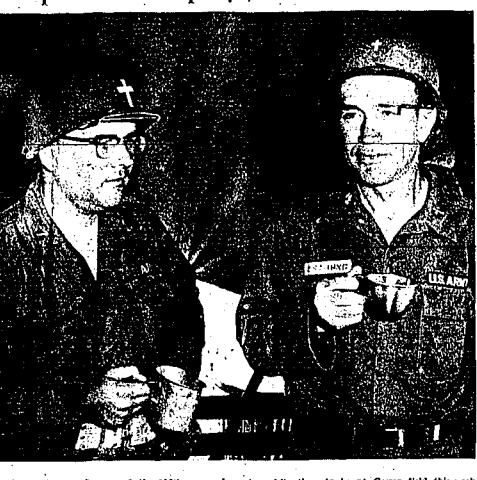

TUCKER'S NATIONAL WHIRLIGIG

WASHINGTON, June 12.—Sen. Lyndon B. Johnson's presidential campaign faces a grave challenge to Democratic solidarity and victory as a result of the nomination of Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey to the vice-presidential slot.

Although such a disclaimer is customary with presidential entries, it has special force with respect to Senator Johnson. He is a far more influential figure as senate majority leader than as presidential candidate.

Democratic dilemma.—The Democrats' difficulty over the nomination of Hubert H. Humphrey is unfortunate from the standpoint of national unity in this hour of world crisis.

Senator Johnson has virtually issued an ultimatum to the effect that, if he is rejected after his seven primary triumphs and demonstrations of popular support, he will resign his senate seat.

WHAT FORCES CONTROL DEMOCRATIC PARTY? Johnson's Democratic prestige, which is implicit in his candidacy, rests on a broader base. It provides a nucleus for the forces which control the present-day Democratic party.

It is proposed that the question of whether the Democratic party is a representative of the people, or a sort of "one horse show" hampered and held together by racial, regional, economic and radical forces, should be brought to a referendum.

UP TO JAPAN In the light of the explosive political situation in Japan, there is good cause for worry over President Eisenhower's scheduled trip there later this month.

Sen. J. W. Fulbright, chairman of the senate foreign relations committee who is given to casting aspersions on the president's good sense on his side when he suggests that the President put the trip off until fall.

It is not an easy matter. The state department's postponement would be interpreted in Tokyo as an evidence of weakness. We are also concerned that a delay might precipitate the fall of Premier Kishi's government.

These leftists have concentrated all their weight on trying to force cancellation of Eisenhower's visit. If he did call it off, the action would be hailed in Japan, Red China and Moscow.

On the other hand, the Japanese are a highly volatile people. Their riots have been frequent. They allow their emotions to run riot and even in their legislative deliberations. They have several times stormed Kishi's residence.

In these circumstances, the President's visit would be a serious liability. Administration officials still appear confident they can protect him no matter how severe the reaction. But this does not change the prospect that the reaction may be dangerous.

Certainly a postponement ought to be manageable without suggesting weakness on America's part. The only real danger properly belongs to the Japanese.

They have a duly constituted government. Today it is threatened both by riot and by the so-called "leftist" groups who may have control of the Diet, its party's 125 members.
