Miss Universe, the sun-kissed beauty from Puerto Rico, is pulling all the stops to make this year's contest the most glamorous yet in the history of the pageant.

At the head of the winners' parade is the Miss Universe who returned to the scene of her triumph in a decided exception to the usual custom of winners who have gone home to their respective countries.

Who have the previous winners been?

Patricia of Greece, who got a questionable adjective when she was crowned Miss Universe in 1952.

She married Miami hotel magnate G. David Schuler, Jr. in 1954.

Miss Universe and Miss United States, Carol Morris, who married a Texas oilman and now lives in Houston.

They are among four of the eight previous winners now married and living largely away from the limelight. Others are: the first of them all, Armi Kuusela of Finland, who won in 1951 and married a Filipino banker; and her four children.

The first of the two American winners, African Stevenson, 1954 Miss Universe, presently a housewife in Greenboro, N.C.

Marina Zolotas of Colombia, top beauty in 1958, is to be married in the summer.

Two single at the moment are Missy Zander of Peru, winner in 1957, and the current titleholder, Akiiko Kojima of Japan, who's been too busy traveling for the last year to say bachelor to anyone.

About the only positive exception to the bright-lights-for-me rule is Miss Universe of 1953, Christine Merlet.

A similar rally is scheduled for July 24 in Chicago prior to the Democratic national convention.

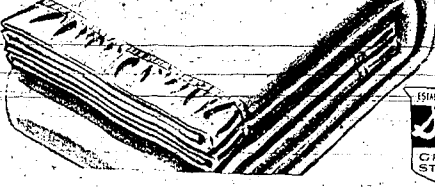

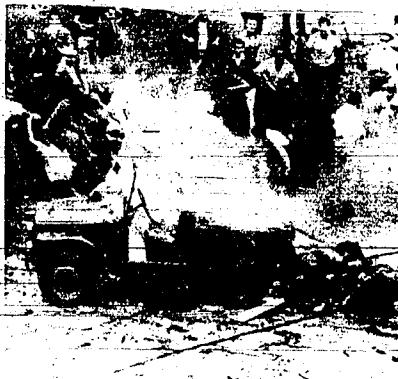

2-Party Plans Developed in German State

WEST GERMANY, July 4 (AP)—Major political developments here today were the evolution of West Germany as an American-style democracy.

The country is moving closer to a two-party system under two electoral groupings much like the Republican and Democratic parties.

There is one basic difference, however—both West German parties are considerably less of tight American counterparts.

Parliament Differ Little

But the framework there and it is growing more and more alike. There are two major differences between the Christian Democratic Union (CDU) and the Socialists, however, than those between the Republicans and Democrats.

The two major developments last night:

1. The Socialist party officially abandoned its opposition to the CDU's policy-of-strength inside the western alliance and announced it would live by the alliance and the spirit of every international agreement negotiated by Chancellor Konrad Adenauer, a CDU leader.
2. The German party, a long-time ally of Adenauer, collapsed as a parliamentary coalition and two-thirds of its deputies joined Adenauer's CDU.

There are now only three parties represented in the Bundestag lower houses: The CDU—the Socialists and the Free Democrats, the latter a small party along the lines of Britain's Liberal party.

The Free Democrats historically have been allies of the Socialists in foreign affairs and of the CDU in domestic affairs. Their chief spokesman is Adenauer's party.

Marxist Idea Dropped

All year the Socialists officially abandoned the old Marxist ideal of nationalization of industry. Last year they dropped pacifism as a policy and acknowledged that only being militarily strong on the West front could prevent a communist takeover.

Thus when the voter goes to the polls in next year's federal election, he will be faced with a choice as the American voter and the choice has been made in policy.
