Americans Streamlined to Vote; New Records Are Likely

WASHINGTON, Nov. 8 (UPI and AP)—Americans surged to the polls in record numbers today to choose a new president. They also picked 21 of the 100 members of the U. S. senate, all 437 house members, 27 governors and thousands of other state and local officials. By mid-afternoon no national trend was observable in the presidential returns to either Republican Vice President Richard M. Nixon or Democratic challenger, Sen. John F. Kennedy.

The Democratic candidate, Nixon, was leading 9,562 to 4,951. But most of the votes in this tally were from the 10 states where the election was held. Kansas where a double election was held, a preliminary report of the state's returning officer showed Nixon leading 4,829 to 4,829.

The number of votes reported from Kansas was too low to be indicative of what might be the final outcome in that state. Yet there were facets to intrigue political experts.

For one thing, Nixon was run as a Democrat in Kansas and as a Republican in Missouri. It is noted that a Republican candidate, Sen. Edward C. Johnson, had been elected in Kansas in objection to a recommendation by a governor, and that the state's French bloc is imported in an effort to improve the best yield of wheat.

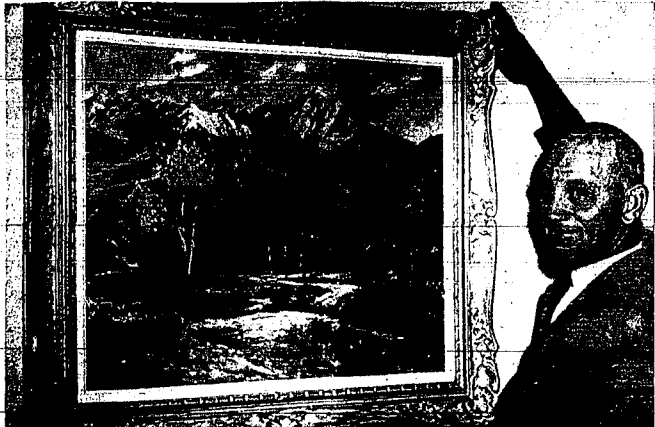

Averell Harriman and West German Ambassador Hans Kroll, the Soviet premier drank "to friendship of all peoples, to peace, to the United States, to the existence in order to live in peace and friendship." 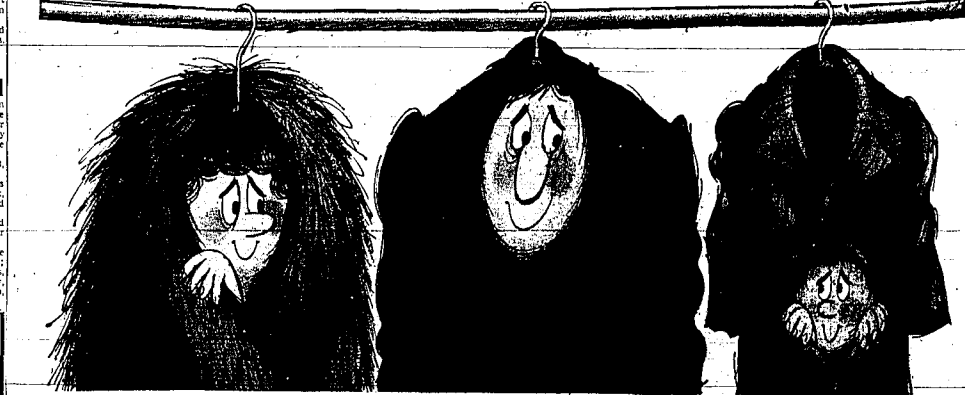
