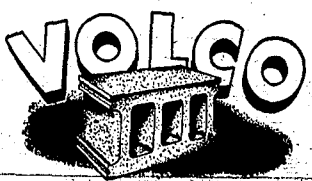

THEY WANT TO WORK An associated Press story from Kellogg pertaining to the six-month strike against the Bunker Hill and American Smelting and Refining companies should set Idaho people to thinking.

According to the AP, striking miners in the Coeur d'Alene mining district of north Idaho have a back-to-work pact with Kellogg, pressing their desire to return to their jobs. About 200 miners turned out for the meeting to discuss a petition from the newly-formed Workers' Mental Workers' union, asking the national labor relations board to conduct an election to decertify the Mine-Mill union.

When attending the meeting unanimously voted to appoint a committee to contact an impartial lawyer to learn what their rights were in the NLRB election.

From this report it should be apparent that the miners are unhappy with the Mine-Mill union, and that feeling will undoubtedly precipitate a jurisdictional labor dispute, and that this in themselves would like to go back to work.

That this strike in north Idaho is far more serious and significant than most of us realize is indicated by the attention which is being given in the current issue of Time magazine.

Recently, while talking with a press service representative thoroughly familiar with the situation in the Coeur d'Alene mining district, we asked him for his opinion as to the underlying cause of all the trouble.

To his way of thinking the Mine-Mill union officials are mostly responsible. Under prevailing circumstances, he thinks the union bosses have been unreasonable.

There is little demand for lead and zinc and low prices for these commodities make a profitable operation next to impossible.

Strangely enough, the miners, even under these circumstances, have been drawing good wages, and the Coeur d'Alene district work. But not so with their leaders who have insisted on making greater demands.

Meanwhile, scores of families are moving back to Kellogg, and the Coeur d'Alene district is slowly being re-populated.

Now it's a different story and the labor leaders will not be any in presenting their case to the beneficiaries of their votes and their cash.

It will take courage for the new administration to weigh these demands carefully to determine whether they are thinking primarily of the welfare of the thousands of workers they are supposed to represent.

Hundreds of miners in the Coeur d'Alene mining district have demonstrated how they feel in this regard.

FROM THE HORSE'S MOUTH Those who have expressed concern that the Soviet Union is catching up with the American economy would do well to heed the words of Soviet economist, A. Agabekov, whose words are translated in a Harvard Business school publication.

Comrade Agabekov cheerfully forecasts that the Russians will overcome our towering lead over them within 5 to 15 years in most of our fields. He admits that Russian production now is less than that of the United States, and that per capita the production is even lower.

The Russians are automating their production, he observes, and still can't get a man-hour productivity of the U. S. because of the armies of sweepers, inspectors and other auxiliary workers employed in their mills and factories.

As for coal mining, he observes, Russian productivity is low because the Russians habitually cut into the coal face from the wrong side. He observes, also, specific problems that will be hard to solve.

But he relies on the iron determination of the managers behind the iron curtain to see that the Russians will not be able to get their goods to remain pretty short or so shoddy for the next 15 years or so.

Who who hope our economy can be kept ahead of the Russians, he particularly is interested in one area where the Russian economist thinks we are pushing.

That is in the field of government activities. He declares, however, that we are big winners in that far fewer of their work programs are governmental activities.

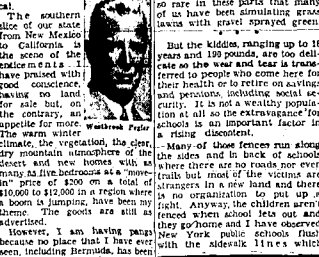

### '60 Election Brings Demo South Gains

NEW ORLEANS, La., Nov. 10 (AP)—The 1950 election brought a Democratic resurgence in the South and little Republican success in extending recent gains, an Associated Press survey of 100 presidential electors today revealed.

President-elect John F. Kennedy polled more votes in the 11 Southern states than any previous candidate with 40.9 per cent of the vote.

Nixon's Percentage Lower

Vice President Richard Nixon outdistanced all previous candidates, but his percentage of the vote was lower than that of three per cent from President Eisenhower's 1950 total. This comparison was based on 100 per cent nationally.

Majority of returns in several metropolitan areas showed that votes against the Democrats were concentrated in the West and the public. The implication is that a conservative vote for a Republican seriously eroded the Republican vote strength.

Kennedy Had 50.1 Per Cent

Unofficial, nearly complete returns compiled by the Associated Press today showed Kennedy had nearly 504,000 votes, or 53.3 per cent of the 11 million votes, to Nixon's 402,100, or 47.1 per cent.

Independent Democratic electors polled in California, Oregon and Louisiana's State Rights party had 1.6 million votes.

In 1950 Eisenhower led with 42,115, or 50.5 per cent; in 1952 Adlai Stevenson's percentage would probably have been higher than Stevenson's had it not been for the Communist vote in rural, Protestant areas.
