Soviets Say Kennedy Wants 46 Die in Carrier Fire; They'll Build Bigger Trade Pact

WASHINGTON, Dec. 20 (UPI)—The Soviet Union announced today it will cut its defense spending "considerably" and create 2 million more jobs with a five per cent increase in real incomes, Finance Minister Nikolai S. Podgorniy added, however that there could be no "paper" defense cuts because there is as yet no agreement on disarmament.

Podgorniy announced a draft budget for 1961 to the supreme soviet meeting in the Kremlin today. He was preceded by a declaration of vice chairman of the council of ministers Leonid Brezhnev, who is also chairman of the state committee, who presented proposals for economic growth for the coming year, a 10 per cent increase of the current year's production.

Cuba, Russia Sign Bigger Trade Pact

MOSCOW, Dec. 20 (AP)—Proclaiming their solidarity in foreign affairs, the Soviet Union and Cuba have signed a new and bigger trade agreement today, the Soviet Union said.

The Soviet Union said it is ready to buy 27 million tons of Cuban sugar—nearly half the crop—if the United States permits in return to buy sugar from its Caribbean neighbors by a million tons annually under a pact valid Feb. 1, 1961.

Africa Group Signs Mutual Defense Pact

Houphouët-Boigny said the next French African summit meeting would be held on Jan. 15-20 in Yaounde, Cameroon Republic. He said the military defense accord will be signed at that meeting.

The French language states also announced the creation of a 12-nation airline to be called "Air Africa."

Fire Safety Tips Are Given For Christmas Decorations

In the three days beginning at midnight Christmas eve 40 per cent of their lives in fire, in this country, reports the National Fire Protection Association.

Fire takes no holidays, the opened book reminds the board here: Christmas tree lights should be the following safety precautions for a fire-free Christmas.

When you select your Christmas tree choose a fresh-cut tree that is firmly attached to the trunk. The tree outdoors until just before Christmas. It will stay fresher in the room away from radiators. If it will stay given better.

Set the tree in the corner part of the room away from radiators, heaters, and the fireplace. This not only reduces the possibility of fire but will keep the tree from falling over.

The safety of your own Christmas tree should be checked at each step up to 40 miles an hour, can turn a breeze into a fire.

Always use electric lights on the tree—never candles. Lighting sets should be checked before being placed on the tree. Those with frayed wiring should be discarded.

When buying new lights look for the use of lead sheathing approval by Underwriters Laboratories. A switch should be provided for turning the tree lights on and off from distance from the tree.

Clear exit passages by at least 40 inches. Do not use tinsel or garlands.
