



Kidiculous Dria ridiculous to even consider the pro-posal of trading stamps to finance an Idaho territorial centennial celebration. The proposal from a trading stamp com-pany offikial is the latest development in what has amounted to a series of des-peration measurest to raise funds for the proposed celebration. When the special ession of the Idaho legislature refused to approve 300.000 for the celebration, that ahouid have been sufficient. The regular session of the legislature also de-clined to appropriate funds. Consideration of the trading stamp proposal would serve no purpose other than to emphasize the despirate attempts of a for interested people to finance the celebration by any means.

to generate any enthusiasm for an évent proposed for somo two years in the fu-ture. Idaho may yet have an organized cen-tennial celebration in 1963, atthough it way not be on the scale envisioned by current proponents. By the time the next regular zession of the state legislature convenes at the first of Januery, 1963, there may be considerable inlerest in the centennial. At any rute, some 440000 has been spent alrendy in planning proposid cele-bration details, so it would appear no time would have to be wasted on prelim-ianties in event of a 4963 sppropriation. Some residents of Twin Fulls may re-cell this city's rather ambilious observ-ance of 50 years of statehood back in 1960. Many events were armaged for the cele-bration, without the use of state funds Some of the features that may be recalled readily were "wooden"-money.-ploneer-costumes, fireworks and a rather ambi-dios spagaant that drew capacity crowds to Lincoin field.

Perhaps such sup-port would be given to local centennial plans in 1963. At any rate, it would appear that ap-proval of the trading stamp suggestion would place the state of Idaho in the position of being obligated to a trading stamp firm. In view of the considerable squation in recent years to outlaw trad-ing stamps, the position would be doubly embarmasing.


