



Atabo's farmers have gained-an-un-expected edge in their fight to avoid federal controls of potatoes and the ad-vantage seems to suggest an effective method of battling the threat. Special meetings have resulted in growers re-newing in no uncertain terms their op-position to federal controls. And the mere fact that President Kennedy did not propose potate controls in his farm message to congress was an encouraging sign.

The two factors together help morale in the uphill battle and seem to suggest that the flight might not be quite so hopeless as it appeared a few short weeks ago.

Sen. Frank Church announced prior to the President's farm message that he had implored the President not to make any mention of potato controls. Whether-Mr. Kennedy omitted such mention in deference to Idaho's juilor senator is a matter for conjecture, but the fact remains he didn't spell out spud controls for congress.
