Roper's came to Buhl in Janu-ary, 1948, with the new store un-der the management of LaMont der the management of LaMont Parish Parish began his carer with Roper's in 1932 at Burley. He was a graduate of Burley high school and attended what is now Idaho State college in Po-catello.

Although they had earlier purchased another-building, Roper's found a better location with the purchase (of Day's clothing alore. The interior of the store was completely reliabled and new lighting installed. Many overtime hours followed much new merchandise was brought in, displays were prepared.

The new store opened for crowds of customers only three weeks after the nurchase of Davy's, and has grown ever since. See pictures and more story on

When William Roper opened his first men's apparel store in Burley back in 1912 he had no idea then that it would grow and prosper into the fine network of prosper into the line network of stores now covering southern Idaho. In fact, during those early days there were times when he wondered, if the whole proper ingul collapse. But Wil-liam Roper didn't leave his home in Missouri to give up in a small town of the Idaho desert that was only seven years old.

Roper was born Oct. 27, 1883, and attended local schools be-fore entering Southwest Baptist college and attended Springfield Normal and Business college. During this time he was already During this time he was already picking up background in the clothing business by working part and full time for Schwau Brothers Clothing store in

Brothers Clothing store in Springfield.
In 1911, Roper and I. E. Mas-ters, one of Roper's customers, decided to take Horace Oreeley's advice and go west. They se-cured temporary employment in Boise before they made their move to Burley. Early in 1912 Roper and Mas-

ters opened their men's wear store under the name of Roper and Masters Clothing store. and Moders Clothing store, However, poor health forced Masters to retire a year later and Roper, after purchasing Masters' interest, added a new partner, E. M. Tomlinson. A new store was constructed and they expanded their merchandise to cover ladies' and children's wear and piece goods. Footwear was also added

Evidently the call to come west fell on Roper's younger brother, T. J. (Jack) Roper, because soon after finishing business college he came to Idaho to work for his
