

U.S. Tops Again

Down through the years American nive developed some sort of phobia-and considerable misconceptions—about naving the best and biggest of every hing in the world. There's even one fiel thing in the word. There seven one inclining in which Americans generally are not aware they excel, yet this nation leads the next contender by a comfortable margin, an edge that will be widened considerably in the next year or so from all

Indications.

It's this little matter of public debt.
The U.S. government debt is the heaviest The U.S. government debt is the heaviest, per capita in the world. Figures haven't been compiled yet up to the end of 1962, but by the end of 1961, each American's share of the federal debt was \$1,607. The incircial competitor for the dubious honor was England with a paitry \$1,664 per capita debt. No other nation is even in the running for the distinction, although Canadians, Australians and New Scalanders each owed something like \$1,000.
