House Vote Kills Bills Against Job Discriminations

BOISE, Jan. 28 (P)—The house killed by a 46-16 vote today a bill that would have prohibited job discrimination against persons between 40 and 65 because of age. Opponents said it would be unenforceable. Repeal for reintroduction in the house was a re-apportionment bill that would add 16 members to the house, all going to more populous Idaho counties. Counties with a single representative would retain their representation. The state affairs committee voted unanimously for the formula.

Rusk Tells Of Buildup For Castro

WASHINGTON, Jan. 28 (U)—The Soviet Union has placed four heavily armed combat groups in Cuba, U. S. intelligence officials said today. They are flying MIG fighters capable of carrying nuclear warheads. Secretary of State Dean Rusk said.

The continued presence of Soviet troops in Cuba is a matter of real concern to the United States, Rusk said. He said that the United States administration line that the Soviet forces essentially are offensive in nature. He said that the best U. Icy Clutch Sweeps Death Rate Past 270

Forty-four drifts posed snow emergencies in the Northeast, today and the temperature plunged to new sub-zero records in the midlands. The death toll in one of the greatest cold waves in the century across the nation's eastern two-thirds during a period of almost two weeks climbed past 270. The bitter cold stretched from North Dakota to Texas and westward to Pennsylvania. Little relief was in sight.

Slight Rise In Mercury Hits Europe

LONDON, Jan. 28 (P)—Winter's fury continued to lash southeastern Europe today, but elsewhere milder weather brought some relief.

However, freezing temperatures at night turned partly thawed snow into ice and made highways more hazardous again. The latest unofficial toll of deaths attributed to the Arctic weather rose to more than 400.

Fresh snow was reported in central Greece, along Italy's Adriatic coast and as far south as Bari, and all across Hungary.

Seven inches of snow were reported in cities along Italy's northeastern coast. Lake Trarone, south of Florence, froze over for the second time this winter.

The Greek air force parachuted medical supplies, food and fodder for livestock to several mountain villages in Macedonia, isolated by snow for a week.

Heavy snow piled up in several areas of the north and northeast. Slides piled up snow drifts over most of Hungary, blocking many highways.

Milan and Rome were sunny but temperatures still ranged down to 24 degrees.

The thaw returned to The Netherlands with the temperature expected to reach 37.

Food for Americans

If you enjoy the flavor or chill, use it in many ways. Here are two good suggestions:
CHILI HUSH PUPPIES
(2 dozen, 1 1/2-inch)
1 cup white corn meal
1/2 cup sifted all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon double-acting baking powder
1/2 teaspoon soda
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon chili powder
3 tablespoons instant minced onion
1/2 cup sour milk
2 tablespoons water
1 egg, beaten
Combine corn meal, flour, baking powder, soda, salt, chili powder and instant minced onion in a mixing bowl. Mix well. Stir in milk, water and egg. Let batter stand 5 minutes. To bake: Drop from a teaspoon into hot deep fat, preheated to 370 degrees or until an inch square of bread browns in 60 seconds. Drain on absorbent paper. Keep warm in a pre-heated slow oven (300 degrees) while cooking remaining batter.
Serve with chili sauce or with the main course. These are especially good with fish. If desired, make these hush puppies a day before they are to be served. Reheat in a moderate oven.

Chili Skillet Stew
(10 servings)
2 pounds ground chuck
1 tablespoon shortening, 1/2 pound (2 cups) canned tomatoes
1 1/2 cups dried potatoes
1/2 cup sliced carrots
1 cup water
1/2 cup instant minced onion
3 teaspoons salt
12 ounces can (1 1/2 cups) whole kernel corn
5 teaspoons chili powder
1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
1 teaspoon oregano leaves
Brown meat in shortening in a 9 or 10-inch skillet. Add tomatoes, potatoes, carrots, water, instant minced onion and salt. Cover and cook 25 minutes or until vegetables are tender. Add corn, chili powder, black pepper and oregano leaves. Cover and cook 10 minutes. Serve hot.
