



#### **Annual Shareowners' Meeting**

Because electric service is an important part of daily life affecting every family, you may be interested in the following resume of information presented to Idoho Power Company shareowners during the past week

#### Increase in Use of Electricity

Snake River Valley homes, farms, businesses and industries served by the Company have more than doubled their use of electricity during the past ten years. Growth in the use of kilowatt hours has been greater-than that of any other Pacific Northwest utility system. Abundant supplies of power have been provided by the construction of generating, transmission and distribution facilities to keep ahead of demand.

Employment in manufacturing industries served by the Company increased 128 per cent from 1952 to 1961 (latest available data), Idaho's rate of economic growth with an ample supply of dependable, tax-paying power has exceeded any other northwest state.

#### New Investment in Electric Facilities

Supplementing the Company's \$350,000,000 investment in electric service facilities, an additional \$140,000,000 will be spent within the next six years on system projects.

Dynamic growth immediately ahead includes the building of the 425,000-kilowatt Hells Canyon Dam at an estimated cost of nearly \$70,000,000; and Joint construction of more than \$70 miles of 230,000-volt transmission lines with four neighboring investor-owned

The Hells Canyon project is by far the largest construction undertaking planned for this area, and will give a tremendous boost to the economy through local purchases, payrolls and new, state and federal taxes.

Proposed new transmission line construction (mentioned above) is estimated to cost about \$22,000,000. It will provide more efficient use of existing power resources in a five-state intermountain area, and maximum coordination of operations to meet peak requirements of all five participating companies. It will also permit construction of larger, more afficient generating plants at lower unit costs.

#### This Is a Tax-Paying Investment

New construction will be performed with tex-paying venture capital, not will subsidies from the nation's texpayers that only serve to increase already staggering deficits.

Idaho Power Company Is the state's largest tax-payer with an estimated 1963 tax payment of \$16,000,000 to local, state and federal governments. This represents slightly more than one-third of each dollar received from customers for electric service.

Idaho Power Company pays the highest taxes in rela-tion to its revenues of any northwest utility company. Tax differences considered, Idaho Power's revenue per kilowatt hour is the lowest.

The Company's payroll amounts—to approximately \$8,000,000 this year.

#### Irrigation Development Substantial

Low-cost electricity for irrigation pumping has made possible tremendous reclamation of desert lands.
