Striking Home

If anyone had an uneasy feeling while reading about the supremic court decision in the Colorade river feat, there was good reason. Under no stretch of the imagination could the high court and the continue merely to the matter at hand. As everyone is well aware, supreme court decisions are the basis for the law of the land. If any interpretation were needed, it was supplied by Judge William O. Dottgins who differed sharply with the 6-3 decision.

"The present decision grants the federal bureatients y power and command over water rights in the 17 western states that it never has had, that it always wanted, that it could never persuade congress to grant and that this court up to now has consistently refused to recognize." Justice Douglas declared. "The decision today . . . has made the dream of the federal bureating to the supreme courtibing from the federal bureating the bower administration marketing extension. Secretary Udall's government-by-edict extended the Bonneville marketing sea to include all of southern Idaho. Immediately the proponents of public power started huming the same ullaby: "Generation of electricity will continue to be subordinate to use of water for irrigation and other project purposes in accordance with applicable state laws. And now the supreme court comes along and gives the federal government full authority

the supreme court comes along and gives the federal government full authority ever waler rights.

Interior Secretary Udall used wonderful restraint in commenting on the decision, saying the decision underscored "the urgent need for constructive water statesmanship and a regional approach to the water needs of the rapidly growing Pacific Southwest."

Read the words again, and then apply them to Magic Valley and Snake river. One interpretation is that "constructive water statesmanship" means federal control and certainly "regional approach" gets back to the same old Conmibia valley authority plant that is gallouing along now faster than ever.

Either—the Bonneville ruling or the supreme court decision would pose" at threat to Snake river water rights, but take both developments together and it's enough to cause nightmares. All of a sudden the farmer who has always quanted his bendanter so zeniously finds that he's outlinked, in danger of being cut off from the headgates.

Now the public power hoys can be expected to step up their chorus of phony assurance, deploring "scare talk" and "uninformed alarmists."
