Bonneville's below-cost power rates will not support existing pay-out schedules. Neither will they furnish the money on which further irrigation development will depend. Is reclamation progress stopped in southern Idaho?

The Bureau of Reclamation found it necessary to charge its customers an average of 5.3 mills for wholesale power in order to meet Irrigation project re-payment ob-ligations. How can Bonneville reduce that wholesale rate about 40% - as it promises to do - and still meet project obligations?
