WASHINGTON, July 3 (AP)—The United States received and immediately rejected today a Soviet demand for release of a Russian U. S. employee and his wife arrested on spy charges Tuesday. The Soviet Union demanded release of the two today, contending they were "unlawfully arrested," and had diplomatic immunity. A state department spokesman said this country rejected the request with a reply that the immunity of such U. S. employees does not extend to activities such as espionage not connected with United Nations activities.

Newspaper Advertising Plans Noted

CHICAGO, July 3 (Special)—Sears, Roebuck and company expects to spend more than 60 million dollars for newspaper advertising this year, the company announced today.

George H. Struthers, vice president in charge of merchandising, gave this estimate based on preliminary reports and forecasts for the remainder of 1963 from more than 750 Sears retail stores across the nation.

At the same time, he reported actual expenditures lined up amounted a new record of 58 million dollars for newspaper advertising. This was 3 million dollars more than the 1962 expenditure, he said, and represented the fourth consecutive year that Sears newspaper advertising has topped 50 million dollars.

The 58-million dollars represented 71 1/2 per cent of Sears' total retail media expense of 81 1/2 million dollars. Advertising through circulars, magazines, radio and television, and miscellaneous media accounted for the remainder.

Sears' continuing expansion program has resulted in a steady increase in the use of newspaper advertising. Struthers pointed out, the number of Sears stores has increased from 62 in 1946 to a total of 748 at the end of 1962.

In the same 16 years, Sears stores have invested more than 60 million dollars in newspaper advertising. The company's sales have doubled — from 2.3 billion dollars in 1946 to 4.6 billion in 1962.

"This is tangible evidence of our continuing faith in the potency of newspaper advertising," Struthers said.

"From the day Sears opened its first retail store," he said, "the company has made greater and greater use of newspapers. It is obvious that Sears store managers continue to regard the newspaper as their major medium for more than historical reasons. Their evaluation is based on the day-to-day results in their stores."

Sit-ins Set By Freedom Rider Group

NEW YORK, July 3—A caravan of "freedom" riders leaves tomorrow for the Cambridge, Md. area where they plan to conduct sit-downs. Part of July sit-in demonstrations in an effort to desegregate restaurants and other public facilities.

As many as 1,000 persons are expected to participate in the expedition, which has been planned by the Campus Americans for Democratic Action (CADA) and the Congress of Racial Equality (CORE).

A spokesman for the CADA said the integrated group will leave on charter buses early in the morning and return late tomorrow night "unless we're all in jail."

It has not been decided yet whether the "freedom" riders will demonstrate in Cambridge, Md., the focal point of racial tension in Maryland.

Martial law has been in effect in Cambridge since June 16 and national guard officers have issued an order forbidding racial demonstrations.

23 Feared Dead In Plane Crash

WELLINGTON, New Zealand, July 3—All 20 passengers and three crew members were feared killed today in the crash of a twin-engine airliner.

The New Zealand National Airways DC3 went down in mountains near its destination, Taunanga, on New Zealand's North Island, 50 miles southeast of Auckland.

A ground party set out for wreckage sighted in a heavily wooded area. No sign of life was reported.
