

Schools Will Open Sept. 9 For Wendell

WENDELL, Aug. 20—Wendell schools will open Monday, Sept. 9. The school faculty meetings will be held in the high school study hall at 9 a.m. Friday, Sept. 9.

A potluck picnic will be held Saturday, Aug. 24, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the school grounds.

Registration will be held on Sunday, Aug. 25, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. High school students have received their schedules and are registered on the opening day of school, elementary high school and junior high.

Students will begin school Sept. 9. Children should plan to bring lunch the first week. Grades one through six will be charged \$1 per week for lunch, while parents and adults \$1.50 this year.

Buses will go home at noon the first day of school. Buses will run the same route as last year.

Students of all ages are asked to bring new people to the district's school concerning what they should ride, prior to the opening of school. Telephone number is 436-2950.

Registration in the Wendell schools will be the same as last year. All students will pay a \$10 annual fee. The fee will be \$2.50. High school fees include district registration fee \$7.41 to be refunded at end of year.

The additional fees will be charged for classes that have workbooks, newspapers, etc.

Fees will be charged for English, typing, shorthand, business mathematics, U.S. history, American government, physics, chemistry, biology, earth science, culture classes, each \$1. Bookkeeping and earth science, each \$1, hand \$4 if student will be using the book. Books will be used during the past two years, made three years ago.

Students body activity tickets may be purchased at the high school office prior to the opening football game Sept. 10.
