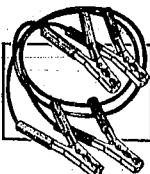

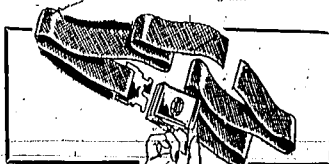

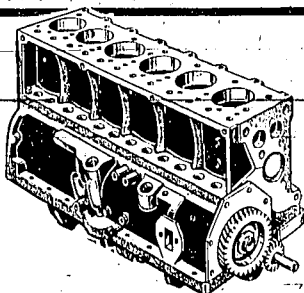

Mrs. Hayes Is Speaker for 79'ers Meet

ALBION, Sept. 3.—Mrs. John F. Hayes, Twin Falls, was guest speaker at the 79'ers organization 42nd annual meeting here Saturday.

Opening prayer was given by Chas. Harrison. Group singing was directed by Mr. and Mrs. Ward Chaburn.

Heads presiding at the meeting, the program was conducted by Olen Lewis, vice president. Seats stated he believed he was the oldest living member of the organization. He said the organization was first started by early settlers who came to southern Idaho by 1890.

Nearly all of them have died and their sons and daughters are responsible to carry on the organization and perpetuate the spirit of the early pioneer, he stressed.

Olen Lewis gave two poems which characterized the faith and fortitude of the early pioneers.

Mrs. Hayes, introduced by Lewis, was dressed in her Centennial dress and sun bonnet which was made by her sister, Mrs. Carrie Crockett, Rock Creek. She told of the early pioneers, noting when the first governor was appointed by the President in Washington, D.C. it took four months for him to arrive in Idaho from Washington.

She also paid tribute to early distinguished men who had a part in making Idaho a territory and also a state. She said Frank Riblett, who was the first president of the 79'ers organization, came to what is now Albion in 1876 and taught the first three months school in the winter of 1877 in what is now Cassia and Twin Falls counties. Riblett was interested in surveying work when Cassia county was created by the state legislature in 1879 he was chosen as the best qualified man in the locality for the office of county surveyor.

During subsequent years he gave valuable service both in local and government surveys. Mrs. Hayes said in 1880 his attention was first attracted to the favorable location on the Snake river as a feasible point for the diversion of water for irrigation.

Later Riblett secured the cooperation of other surveyors and in the following years ran some of the preliminary survey lines on both the north and south sides of the Snake river. He was also among the first in recognizing the project known as the Twin Falls-Salmon river project under the Carey act.

Mrs. Hayes also told the part the gold diggers played in the early settlement of the state and the pony express, and the Ben Haliday stage line. She also told of personal experiences with the late Senator Borah and other influential men. Addison T. Smith and Fred T. Dubois.

She paid tribute to the early settlers and said now that we are celebrating the Idaho Centennial pioneer stories help us appreciate the early pioneer.

Mrs. Hayes is historian of the 79'ers organization.

Workers Aid Survivors of India Quake

NEW DELHI, India, Sept. 3.—Rescue workers with picks and shovels today dug through the ruins of 58 villages in Kashmir devastated by an earthquake which killed an estimated 100 persons and injured about 500.

The earthquake yesterday morning was the worst to hit Kashmir in modern times. The area records up to 20 tremors yearly but rarely has a fatality.

Men from the scene said bodies had been found by this morning, mostly crushed beneath the heavy timber roofs of collapsed barnhouses. They said hundreds of persons were saved because they were working in open fields when the quake struck.

Telephone Workers Sign New Contract

DENVER, Sept. 3.—The representatives of the Mountain States Telephone company and the Communications Workers of America signed a new three-month contract agreement Monday night after the union rejected a previous offer.

In the contract, stage in creases of up to \$3 per week are granted to operators and tolling to craftsmen, depending on new locations and a lump sum of \$2000 for each employee.

The contract, which was ratified by union members at a meeting in Denver, will be in effect for three months.

The settlement also includes improvements in pension, sick and company pay, and hospitalization program.

Next year employees will be granted three weeks' vacation; they attain 10 years service changes in certain working conditions were included.

Negro Family Resisted by Townspeople

POLCROFT, Ga., Sept. 3.—A group of Polcroft residents says there will be no more violence against a Negro family that moved into the white neighborhood but it will use "passive resistance" by demonstrations and boycotts of any business which serves or deals with the family.

The statement was issued Monday after about 1,000 men met for nearly two hours at the Polcroft-Swain club.

The statement deplored the mob violence that greeted Horace and Sarah Baker, who moved into the Delmar development under state police guard Friday night. A mob had blocked the move Thursday.

The statement, which was not signed, emphasized that the Baker family is not welcome in this suburb at Polcroft, but said "the state troopers may leave and the violence will not return."

TO URGE EXPORTS  
WASHINGTON, Sept. 3.—President Kennedy will speak at a White House conference to encourage businessmen to expand U.S. exports. It was announced Monday by Undersecretary of Commerce Franklin D. Roosevelt, Jr. The conference will be held Sept. 17-18.

Disease Resistance May Dip At Certain Point in Space

AMHERST, Mass., Sept. 3.—In nature, a report given at the 11th annual meeting of the American Society for Space Medicine, the resistance to disease may become space medicine's lowest at certain stages of the voyage with potential hazards both in flight and upon return to Earth, a Chinese researcher says.

Receiving on experiments with mice in simulated flights ranging up to 90 days in duration, the researcher, Howard Mordko, said in a report to the annual meeting of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, that the first 10th and 20th days of flight were the most critical periods with the least reliable protection.

A chance infection might occur on board ship at such periods from groups that might have accidentally escaped the sterilization process planned for future space ships to avoid contamination of the moon and the planets with terrestrial bugs.

2. A return to Earth right at the end of the period might leave a man open to infection with a virus or some serious illness ship at 13,000 feet for 30 days showed 78 per cent mortality when exposed to germs of bacterial pneumonia compared with a mortality of only 40 per cent at ground level.

## Sweden Is First Stop For Johnson

STOCKHOLM, Sept. 3 (AP)—Vice President Lyndon B. Johnson arrived today for the first stop on a 15,000-mile tour he hopes will tighten bonds between the United States and five North European nations.

Johnson, on an unprecedented visit by a high U.S. official to this nation, flew in from Washington after a brief stopover in Ithaca, N.Y., to confer with President Kennedy at the summer White House.

Waiting for the Vice President was a top Swedish delegation, led by Premier Tage Erlander and Foreign Minister Torsten Nilsson, parliamentary representatives lined up to greet Johnson and a military band played on the platform.

## Party Drops Support of Korean Junta

SEOUL, Korea, Sept. 3 (AP)—The Liberal Democratic party dropped its support of South Korea's ruling military junta today with two bold challenges to the junta chairman, Gen. Chung Hee Park.

Liberal Democrats, meeting in a national convention, turned to merge with Park's Democratic Republican party for the Oct. 15 presidential election.

They also elected former Premier Yoo Chan (Tiger) Song to the party's 5-man council, stirring speculation that he might receive the presidential nomination. Song, an outspoken critic of Park, is awaiting trial on several charges, including slandering the government.

## Von Braun Says It Is Premature To Value Moon

WASHINGTON, Sept. 3 (AP)—Rocket scientist Werner von Braun says it is "a little premature" to attach special military importance to landing a man on the moon.

"It would be something like saying the South Sea or Antarctica has great military importance," Von Braun said yesterday. "It undoubtedly has—but we don't feel it very strongly yet."

Von Braun, director of the Marshall Space Flight center at Huntsville, Ala., discussed the U.S. space program in an interview with Rep. Harold G. Oesterlin, R., N.Y.

BURLINGTON, Ia., Sept. 3 (AP)—Mrs. Minnie Jones, 34, begins a four-day jail term today but still have bank-er's hours behind bars.

## Trieste Finds Debris on Ocean Floor

WASHINGTON, Sept. 3 (AP)—The navy said yesterday the deep-diving bathyscaphe Trieste last week photographed debris that may have come from the sunken nuclear submarine Thresher.

Authorities said the pictures showed battery plates and other objects. The pictures were taken on the bottom of the Atlantic about 220 miles off the New England coast where the Thresher sank April 10 with 129 men aboard.

None of the objects has been positively identified, the navy said. Trieste is scheduled to make another series of dives in the same general area after undergoing an overhaul at Boston naval yard.

## Rockefeller Calls For Big Tax Cut

NEW YORK, Sept. 3 (AP)—Nelson A. Rockefeller of New York urges big and immediate tax cuts and a program to protect the nation's gold supply.

He made the proposals Monday night in a statement criticizing President Kennedy's fiscal policies.

Rockefeller accused Kennedy of using "tardy half-measures" to combat unfavorable international balance of payments that could cause "a crisis of confidence in the dollar."

## School Growth

WASHINGTON, Sept. 3 (AP)—Steadily mounting enrollment "have increased the expenditures—and the income—of the nation's colleges and universities by more than 25 per cent, the U.S. office of education says.

The agency's figures, in a report released yesterday, were based on a sampling of 393 of the 2,644 public and private colleges and universities over the two-year period ended June 30, 1962.

The study showed, among other things, that state governments were the largest single source of income in 1961-62, "paying nearly 22 per cent of college revenues, with student tuition and fees ranking second and federal grants third."

LONDON, Sept. 3 (AP)—Oliver Mariotti, acquitted on charges of attempting to spy for the Soviet Union, will be barred from continuing his nuclear research job in Britain.

The 40-year-old Italian-born spokesman for the British atomic energy authority said Monday, night Mariotti's British contract, due to expire Sept. 30, will not be renewed.

It's called Labor day week-end rioting and more than 400 arrests at Hampton Beach, Seaside, Ore., Ocean City, Md., and Lake George, N.Y., attest to its popularity.

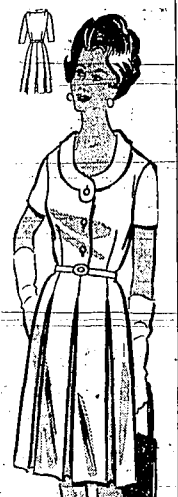

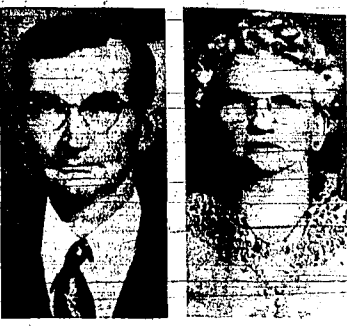

**Young Moderns With Education Land Good Jobs**

By VIVIAN BROWN

Sometimes you have a better chance to land a good job equipped with a bachelor's degree than a Ph.D.

Many research divisions hesitate to train money who have Ph.D.s fearing they may leave for better jobs before the training period is over, advises Ray Lester, New Brunswick a senior research chemist.

A young Ph.D. just beginning college might keep this in mind. Mrs. Lester says, and major in one specific subject like chemistry instead of ruffling a major. This is an age of specialization, she reminds us.

But she should be suited to the specialty. A girl who wants to be a chemist should have a great deal of curiosity. If she just wants a \$8 to \$10 job, it's not for her.

Mrs. Lester started her career as a chemical secretary with the Squibb Institute of Research. That was in 1959, and there were no women in chemistry, she says. But she worked hard, and her industry paid off. Three other women are in her chemistry division now.

In 1952 she worked on the tuberculosis crash program. She has been working for five years on drugs for mental illness.

"There is always the excitement of looking forward to accomplishing something great," everyone in the laboratory keeps saying in mind, although we can't have a crash program on that."

Like many of her co-workers, Mrs. Lester believes that cancer is a virus that will be modified with a drug yet to be compounded.

She worked on the sulpha drug research project is 1940, specifically sulphonamide, but antibiotics have almost completely replaced the sulphas, she says.
