LATER...

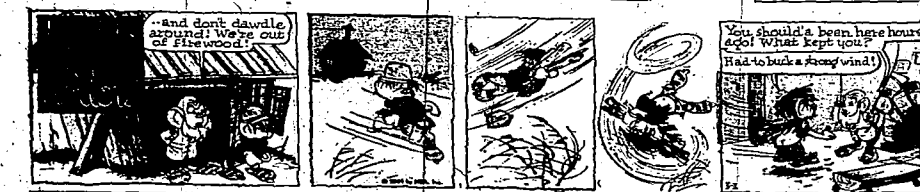
DAINTY, I'M SORRY DAT ME PLANS TA SELL YER MOUNTAIN DIDN'T JELL!

THAT'S BECAUSE YOU IDIOTS HAVE JELLY WHERE YOUR BRAINS SHOULD BE! GOOD-BYE!

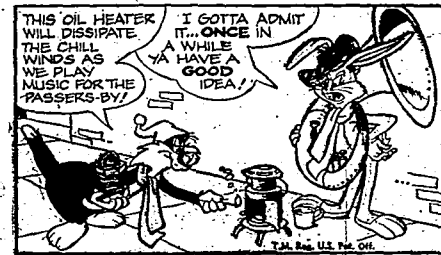

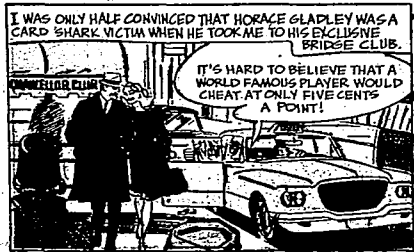
