# Committee Probes Charge Yanks Fight With Bad Weapons

WASHINGTON, May 13 (UPI)—The house armed services committee is looking into charges that Americans are fighting in South Viet Nam with obsolete airplanes and other equipment. The committee, headed by Rep. Carl Vinson, D.-Ga., has asked the Pentagon for a full explanation of recent incidents allegedly involving equipment failure, two members of the committee said. Rep. Ed Fornan, R.-Tex., citing "reports of American lives

being lost . . . because of inadequate and obsolescent equipment," offered the committee a resolution calling for modernization of the Viet Nam war effort. —Scripps Howard writer Jim Lucas reported from Viet Nam Monday that two American pilots, Capt. Edwin G. Shank, Jr., of Winona, Ind., and Capt. Robert M. Brunett of Bethesda, Md., died because the wings came off their planes during combat sorties.

# Cheddi Jagan Apaan Jhat' loses Magic

GUYANA, British Guiana, May 13 (UPI)—In the old days, "Apaan Jhat" was a sort of political open sesame for Cheddi Jagan. A phrase roughly meaning "break your race," it was the cry of dandy handsomeness that could be used—and won't be used—by the Indian Guyana's East Indian leaders on their way to the top in the colony's political heap.

That was in 1953. Today's "Apaan Jhat" doesn't seem to be getting any longer to the magic of "Apaan Jhat."

Two years ago, when Jagan assumed sugar workers to a strike, the response was total. The call to another strike last Friday, however, drew results seriously estimated at less than one percent effective.

The partial effectiveness of the walkout is regarded as solid evidence that the controversial Mr. Arvel Hardy has indeed lost some of his popularity in his local political career. It is also being taken as an early sign of a probable shift in emphasis away from racial issues as a factor in local politics.

Then, as now, the sugar strike was purely political; the grimmer objective this time is Jagan's political survival. His leadership is threatened by new formula that will determine legislative representation in direct proportion to votes cast in the forthcoming November elections.

Although His People's Progressive party was only 42.7 per cent of the 1961 election votes, it has given a clear majority of 35 assembly seats under the system. It was felt that did fairly reflect the fact that Jagan's opposition won 67.3 percent of the vote and should therefore have received a majority of the seats.

The British Colonial office decided the new formula, hopeful would neutralize Jagan and make politically stable conditions regarded as a requisite to plumb independence.

Anxious for the colony's freedom, but not at the price of peace, Jagan's party is attempting to block the November election.

The month-old strike by a predominantly Indian union

believed to be a part of the progressive party's strategy to banish voter registration. It pushed off a still unchecked wave of bombings, shooting and fights between East Indians and Negroes that had been claimed at least 11 lives.

The significant aspect of the strike development is Jagan's failure to muster massive support in a sector dominated by a British Indian. This is regarded as important because of the racial—rather than political or ideological—nature of the British Indians' crisis.

Although Progressive party leadership and policy are considered unquestionably Marxist, the predominantly Indian party has stressed race in its race-and-file relations. As a result, signs of fissures—small but significant—have sprouted within the ranks, where a tiny Workers party and an anti-communist Hindu faction have emerged.

The more affluent Indian classes have been estranged from the party since 1953.

The shape of events in the coming months is said to rest heavily on decisions taken by the evolutionary left-wing elements of the Progressive party.

This wing is reported to have taken the initiative away from Jagan within the party's policy-making body. It is said to be backed by a triumvirate consisting of Jagan's wife Janet; Brindley Benn, a diminutive firebrand who was also deputy prime minister; and Moses Bhagwan, leader of the youth wing.





First Weeks  
of Big Fair  
Discouraging

**NEW YORK, May 13 (UPI)—**The first three weeks of the 1964-65 New York State Fair have been disappointing to fair officials and exhibitors because of poor attendance. A variety of difficulties ranging from bad weather to public resistance to admission admissions costs to increased admissions costs to the fair.

However, a spokesman for fair officials Robert Moses said attendance figures are not considered disappointing yet. Monday's attendance was 184,400, up 11% above last week's average of 147,000 daily. Fair attendance will be approximately 250,000 daily if the projected two-year attendance of 9 million visitors is to be met.

Business is particularly good according to concessionaires. Monday night at the fair grounds were very small crowds in the lake amusement area and in the tower for lack of seats at his "America, Be Our Guest" mineral show. Only a few people were riding in the expensive monorail train which is suspended above this area. Restaurants were empty. The beautiful 125 million dollar production of "Broadway Love" is playing to about 90 percent of capacity in its big theater at the Texas pavilion, while "Wonder World" and "Les Demoiselles de Paris" are drawing large crowds.

Promoters of these shows were informed because the fair puts on a fountain and fireworks show in the industrial area every evening, attracting most fairgoers to their shows.

In the first three weeks of the fair, three attendance figures are recorded—that are higher than any day so far at the current fair. So far the 1964-65 fair is running up to 400,000 behind its 1963.

## Relatives of Americans Killed in Viet Nam Urge U.S. 'Battle to Win'

**WASHINGTON, May 13 (UPI)—**

A group of relatives of American servicemen killed in South Viet Nam published an open letter to President Johnson Tuesday asking that the war be carried to North Viet Nam and that the United States fight a "battle to win" against communism.

The open letter appeared in the form of a full-page advertisement in Tuesday's edition of the Washington Star.

It contained the names of 127 Americans killed in Viet Nam from January, 1961, through March, 1964, and 100 names of relatives of the men. The 100 names were from 42 separate families.

A statement in the advertisement said that "the funds for this advertisement have been provided by a group of Americans in memory of the gallant young Americans who gave their lives in Viet Nam against the communist enemy and in the prayerful hope that their lives

have not been given in vain."

The advertisement asked five questions of President Johnson:

"—Why are the young Americans who are fighting communism? Aggression in Viet Nam—shoulder to shoulder with free Vietnamese soldiers—forced to withstand the onslaught of the communist enemy without having the opportunity to attack the enemy's own territory in the north?"

"—Why do we fight communism with one hand—at a terrible cost to our loved ones—and help communism with the other hand? If international communism is the enemy of our nation, then we must fight. If it is not, then let's bring our young men home—from throughout the world—and submit to international communism's ambition to control the world. We can't have it both ways—it must be one way or the other!"

The advertisement added that

"to make the supreme sacrifice in a war that cannot be won is too great a sacrifice to ask anyone. If we are to battle, let's battle to win! If we are not to do this, Mr. President, please tell us: why?"

Last year's winner, who will receive her second \$100 in the fall, is Alberta Knight, a student at Hicks college, Rexburg.


Another scholarship award went to Pat Austin, who is a campus leader at Idaho State University, Pocatello.
