WASHINGTON, June 1 (B) — The supreme court truck down today an Alabama court order burring the National-Ansochation-for-the-Advancement_of_Colored People from operating in that state. Justice John M. Harlan-delivered-the-ununimous_decision. In Hitigation hat began in 1956, the Montgomery county, Ala., cirnuit court on Dec. 29, 1964, permanently enjoined NAACP from conducting intensiate business in the

state. The ban was on the ground the NAACP had failed to register as a foreign — out-of-state — corporation.

Alahama's supreme court of reb. 28, 1983 affirmed the ch cuit court order, without considering the merits of the cas-

The state supreme court said this was necessary because th NAACP had failed to saids? rules as to the manner in which haw briefs should raise assignments to error.

The NAACP appealed to the U. S. supreme court, contemping it had been deprived of constitutional "freedom of association and due process and equal protection or law.

NAAOP had been given full opportunity to be heard in Alabanua courts and now presented nothing of a federal nature for action by the U. B. supreme court.

In upholding the NAACP contentions, Harlan said, "The judgment below must be reversed."

If a noted that, in view or the long history of the case, the auprenne court had been maked to formulate a decree for entry in the Alabama courts to easure the NAAOP's right to conduct activities in Alabama without further delay.

Harlan said such a course was within the power of the supreme court, but that the high tributal's justices preferred to follow usual practice and send the case back to the Alabana supreme court for entry of a prompt de-

This decree, said Harian, must vacate "in all respects the permanent injunction order issued by the circuit cour of Montgomery county, Alan, and permit the association to take all steps necessary to qualify it to do business in Alabama."

"Should we unhapply be mistaken in our belief that the supreme court of Alahama will promptly implement this disposition, leave is given the association to apply to this court for further appropriate relief." Har-
