





NEW YORK (AP) — The Department of Welfare announced today it had fired a city social service worker who said in an interview he was the leader of the Ku Klux Klan-in-New Jersey.

Frank W. Rosella Jr., 38, who failed to appear after a department hearing Nov. 10, was informed in a letter that he was dismissed by welfare Department spokesman said.

He was to face charges of "incompetence and misconduct," which the department said reflected his continued membership in the Klan, the American Nazi Party and other extreme right-wing groups.

The department also charged that he engaged in political action-forbidden by state welfare regulations.







Vietnamese Twins Have Thanksgiving

NORFOLK, Va. (AP) — For Mrs. Thi-Hoa and Nguyen-Thi-Thuan, a Vietnamese girl who turned out to be twins, this is their first American Thanksgiving.

The twins are now Joan and Jean Badey, the adopted daughters of Marine Sgt. and Mrs. James R. Badey. The sergeant found them in an orphanage in Saigon.

"Thanksgiving is a lot more personal this year," said Badey. "We are thankful that I am home safe and that we have the children with us."

Badey had told the mother superior at Sacred Heart Orphanage in Saigon he wanted to adopt a child, preferably a girl between two and four years old.

"When I came back a couple of days later the little girl turned out to be twins," Badey says. "I couldn't have taken only one, but I'm a better player and I decided to take both."

So the sergeant, 27, picked up his twins, 4 years old, and flew with them to the United States to join his wife, 32.

"We were separated by a long-held hope," he said in his new home at Norfolk.

"We started talking about adoption a year after we were married five years ago," said Badey, who is from Lorretta Burnett of Arlington.

The twins, abandoned by their parents, were among some 75 children, most of them less than six months old, in the Saigon orphanage nursery.

Food in the nursery consisted almost entirely of bread and porridge. Badey said Jean and Joan had never tasted meat.

"They were suspicious of their first meat, but now they like meat best of all," he said.

On chairs near the stove and in their great interest,"

said Mrs. Badey, "are food, television and food — in that order. They become impatient while I'm cooking. They stand behind me, pointing and saying, 'Watch everything I do,'

Turkey More Like-City Dweller Now

CHICAGO (AP) — Your Thanksgiving turkey will be far more like a wild, tough old bird that graced the Pilgrim fathers' — or even your father's — table.

He probably never scratched around in a chicken yard, never saw — or slept — never strutted through the grass and never awaited, with outstretched neck, a swinging ax.

Conceived through artificial insemination, hatched in an incubator, raised in a high-rise henhouse and humanely slaughtered with an electric knife, he has been pampered from the tub to the table.

"There are no down-on-the-farm turkeys," Dr. L. A. Wilhelm, chairman of the Poultry and Egg-Killing Board, said Monday. "They're more like city-dwellers."

Of the 10-million turkeys raised this year, only the number has increased in the past month; about one bird will be eaten during the Thanksgiving period, he said.

"Most will come from huge

turkey farms which raise an average of 100 turkeys at a time. Sixty per cent will have hatched from artificially inseminated eggs. Ninety-eight per cent will have been raised in incubators.

Balloons Will Be Used for Space Study

NEW YORK (UPI) — Dozens of plastic balloons will be released into the upper atmosphere in an experiment to safeguard man's flight to the moon.

The balloons will be important elements in a study to develop defense against a major hazard of space flight: micrometeorites, the fastest flying rocks in space.

These space rocks are a threat because they might puncture the spacecraft, causing a disastrous loss of cabin pressure. Or they could inflict a critical hit on the shielding structure which is indispensable during the fiery reentry into the earth's atmosphere.

Working under a NASA contract, Avco Corporation's Research and Technical Development Division has started to develop the so-called "moon balloon" approach, a means for analyzing the chemical composition of micrometeorites.

Under this approach, a cluster of plastic cloth balloons would be inflated and released

NEW YORK (UPI) — The Lutheran Immigration Service will be examining its program of assistance to Cuban refugees in the light of President Johnson's offer to admit all Cubans who seek entry to the United States, according to Donald E. Anderson, director of the Service.

The Lutheran Immigration Service, a joint agency of the Synodical Council and the National Council of Churches, Missouri Board, has sponsored a Miami program for Cuban refugees that had been scheduled to end officially this fall.
