

Two crashes of light planes on a recent Sunday afternoon in Idaho's Primitive area underscored the dangers of such flying. It happens virtually every summer and plane owners never seem to be able to learn from the example, Following the two crashes, Idaho Aeronauties Director Chet Moulton declared, "It's the same story that has brought tragedy in mountain areas in the past. The oldest rule we preach . . . is that in these high mountain canyons we fly only in the early morning and in the very late evening."

Yet every summer, someone can't wait for favorable flying conditions and a fatal crash occurs. Daytime air, particularly in the middle of the summer, lacks lifting power-of-cooler-air-In-addition, anirplane engine functions less efficiently with hot air. These facts are drummed into pilots from the beginning of their training until the knowledge should become second nature. Anyone is free to guess why they choose to ignore the information.

guess why they choose to ignore the information.

It seems that one or more pilots pay with their lives practically every summer because they choose to fly when they should be waiting. Perhaps it's a case of familiarity breeding contempt. If a filer is tempted to take a chance and gets away, with it, he!l. take the same chance the next time with less hesitation. If he's lucky and doesn't come too close to crashing, he might reach the day when he won't give a second thought to the risk involved. When he reaches that point, his flying days are virtually over.

No one should lump all pilots together because of those who fly into mountains or attempt summer afternoon takeoffs from short, tricky mountain landing Strips. And no one should conclude that flying is unsafe because of crashes like the two that came so cloge together on the recent Sunday afternoon. Instead, it implications all over again that the leading cause of air crashes, particularly those involving small planes, is pilot croor. The term covers a multitude of sins, but most especially the fatal error of not thinking.

In these days of high fire danger, overyone, charged with safeguarding the state's forest and range areas shouldn't healtate to file charges against auguence who may create a danger of fire.


