

### **Brass Tacks Time**

Brass Tacks Time

The long-awaited study concerning relocation of the Twin, Falls airport has been completed and Magic Valley finds. Itself close to a moment of truth. The engineering study recommends a regional airport, to no one's surprise. But the recommended location in the vicinity of Hansen Bridge surprised a good many residents in Magic Valley. It's not far from the site suggested months ago by some persons in the Burley-Rupert area. They had expressed a desire to join Twin Falls in building a regional airport, but balking at getting any farther away from the Mint-Cassia area than Hansen Bridge.

It remains to be seen what public opinion—if any—will be in regard to the proposed location. It also remains to be seen if there will be sufficient favorable reaction from public officials to make the project feasible. As Twin Falls officials have declared over and over in the past year or so, Twin Falls City and County don't have the resources to build a new regional airport.

Although the engineering report covers six alternatives, including the proposed site faer Hansen Bridge, Magic Valley, or enough of the area to provide the necessary tax base, agrees on a regional site near Hansen Bridge, Magic Valley, or enough of the area to provide browed at truly fine regional airport. But if only one other county should see fit to join Twin Falls County in the endeavor, a regional airport probably would be impossible from a financial point of view. That would push the City of Twin Falls back to Joslin Field.

If Magic Valley can get together on this project it will be one more step toward a unity, and singleness of purpose that would give Magic Valley a potent voice of 100,000 persons, all pulling for the same objectives. And Magic Valley could demand of the federal government long-overdue installations that would make the regional airport an all-weather, all-purpose field.



In conjunction with a new regional airport, it might be wise for every community in Magle Valley to think about possibilities of holicopter connections. True, highway travel right now is virtually unrestricted and takes little time. But what about the future? It's foolish to provide only what is required at present while giving no thought to what will be needed in 10 years or longer. That's been the mistake that has hold back for too many communities and regions in the past, including Magie Valley, Just this once everyond should Join forces and plan for the future,
