



Credit Cards

Something like \$20 million will be lost in the United States in 1967 to a new breed of thief, the credit card crook, predicts the National Better Business Bureau.

Bureau.

Currently about 20 million Americans carry one or more credit or charge-account cards, and 1.5 million of their cards are reported lost or stolen annually in the latter category, the number stolen is estimated to range up to 300,000.

"Few credit card holders are really aware of how valuable their cards can be," says Kenneth B. Willson, president of the NBBs. "The man who is exceedingly careful with \$10 bills will scarcely give a thought to his credit card until it turns up missing and somebody else has started to run up charges in his name."

In one case, three Long Island house, wives "hought" \$16,000 worth of merchandise with stolen cards on a monthlong spree. A gambler from Pittsburgh ran up a nationwide tab of \$125,000 on other people's cards. He raised cash on the side by pedding discounted airline tleckets charged on credit cards mislaid by their rightful owners.

A thief need not even risk using a card himself. Reportedly, a "hot" credit card can be sold for as much as \$250 in some of the nation's large cities where cards are accepted like cash and few people bother to scrutinize signatures.

The holder of a card must pay, of course, for purchases made in his name up until the time he reports its loss to the card-issuing firm. Some insurance companies now write policies to cover card holders against such liability.

The NBBB advises credit card holders to take these steps.

Promptly, notify the Issuer of loss. Telephone or wire and then follow up up with a letter.

Never lend a credit card.

Destroy all out-of-date cards and unsolicited cards received in the mail which

you don't intend to use.

Make sure your card is returned after
each-purchase.

Above all, take as much care of your
credit card as you would a signed blank
check on your bank account.
