

1965.
He said U.S. Steel had profits of 349 million; or 34,60 a share, last year compared with 275,57 million, or 48,60 a share, last year compared with 275,57 million, or 48,62 a share, in the previous year. The 1966 earnings per share include about 17 cents from the exchange of pre-ferred stock for some bonds.
Fourth-quarter earnings rose to 539.55 million or 511.11 a share from 349.03 million, or 78 cents a share, in the last quarter of 1965.

U.S. Steel maintained its 60-cents dividend which was in-creased 10 cents at the end of the third quarter of 1966.

Blough told newsmen the economy shows signs of leveling off and, he said, third-quarter 1966 corporate profits, dipped below those of the first two
