"Youth is disintegrating. The young people of the land have disrespect for their elders and contempt for authority in every form. Vandalism is-rife,—and crime of all kinds is rampant among youth. The nation is in peril."

These alarming words were not taken from the report of the President's Commission on Crime, although they might well have been. They were recorded by an Egyptian priest about 200 B.C.

Socrates, Tjob years later, is also said to have lamented that youths no longer obeyed their parents or respected their teachers. Similar complaints have been expressed in every period of human history in the 2,200 years between Socrates and the present—in every generation, in fact.






