If the governor thinks present taxes are going to bring in more money than the state needs, he should so indicate, and suggest where taxes could be trimmed.

In business it is efficient to figure a hidden profit into the budget. In a state government it is just the opposite. In the first place, it is highly unlikely any way will be figured out so the taxpayer actually will ge to back his flat share of the surplus. And, in any event, it seems like a good idea to give the people what they're paying for, not to curtail operations—and-then—say, "Oops, I'm sorry, we charged you too much," and then worry about making a refund.
