Smoking Decline

Five-years' ago this week the U. S.
Surgeon General's report-on—thehealth hazards of cigarette smoking
was published. With it, the tobaccoindustry's longtime denial of a relationship be tween smoking and
statch was effectively shown false.
Since then, antismoking pressures
have continued to mount. And in
1988, for the first time since 1984. 1968, for the first time since 1964, these pressures were enough to lessen slightly the number of cigarettes sold (526.5 billion, do wn from 527.8. billion in 1967, according to a Business Week study).

Business Week study).

But more telling figures are those that show the number of smokers to be declining. One expert estimates there are 1.5 million fewer smokers now than a year ago. Since there are at least 3 million more people of smoking age in the country, this also shows that the proportion of smokers has dropped again, as it has each of the past 10 years. In that decade, the proportion of female smokers increased to about one-third of all women, while the proportion of males smoking dropped from 55 to 40 per cent.

The antismoking campaigns of private and government agencies. TV and radio commercials against the habit, printed warnings on packages, punitive state taxes on tobacco products — all have had effect. The tobacco industry itself, however, admits it has been the TV and radio antismoking messages that have hurt them most. Some in the industry even feel that an outright ban on cigarette commercials would help sales because it would shut off the antismoking messages. They feel they could then spend their \$200-million TV budget to magazines and newspapers and billiboards.

Anyone should know that the inhaling of foreign substances—a kind of private air pollution—would-interfere—with-the-natural-bodily processes. Yet so long as smoking is represented as offering status or relaxation, the effort to counter this false attractiveness must continue.

Ad Ban Off Base

The Federal Communications Commission's proposed ban on television and radio advertising of cigarettes is not only unprecedented; it is also beyond the authority of the FCC and is probably unconstitutional

tional.

The FCC has regulatory power over broadcasting because channels are limited and must therefore be assigned by responsible authority. But its commission gives it no power to say what must or must not be broadcast. Moreover, it is clearly out of its field in making a judgment on the dangers in smoking cigarettes. This is the kind of judgment that is entrusted by slatute to the Food and Drug Administration. But it is out of place in an agency created for the limited regulation of communication media protected by the First Amendment's provisions of freedom of speech and press.

of other killers such as sleeping pills and alcohol? It apparently believes that it does,

American public opinion recognized the injurious personal and public effects of alcoholic beverages by writing their prohibition into the Constitution, later relenting, A constitutional amendment is the proper course if cigarette smoking is to be controlled.

The FCC might get away with its flat for a time, if Congress does not act, for broadcasters are beholden to the agency. But surely the enforcement of such a ruling would be attacked in the courts, and the FCC's legal grounds appear to be non-existen.

The moral grounds of such a federal government edict are certainly null. The government not only sanctions eignreties by taxation; it actually encourages their manufacture and sale through support of tobacco

The issue here is not the morbid-ity that may be assigned to smoking eigereties. It. Is whether: a-federal, agency may, by-deorée,—say, what may, or may not be advertised to the public when there is no question of fraud or other crimes being in-volved, Such authority cannot be tol-erated in a free society.

The situation will not be improved by letting the 7-cent gasoline tax fall back to 6 cents at the end of the year. That would really dry up non-interstate modernization.—B.H.
