

# **Drownings**

Summer months have not yet arrived, but already the season has taken a toll in drowniags. They are a reminder that the invitingly cool waters of lakes, streams and rivers hold a special danger for the foolhardy, the inexperienced and the

young.
Strange waters, inexperienced swimmers and lack of trained life-guards combine with chilling temperatures, months, of swimming inactivity and the exuberance which comes with spring to bring tragedy—

in the water.

It is not by accident that most drownings occur in unsupervised waters, or that crowded beaches at

resorts manned by competent lifeguards experience few drownings.
Parents must instruct children in
the dangers as well as the Joys of
water sports. To permit a child to
play near water without adequate
supervision is to invite a tragedy.
One factor which adds to drownings this time of year is unawareness by parents that their children
are even tempted by the witers.
But a search back in memory will
recall the days when favorite swimming-holes attracted—the young-ofanother generation.
They still do and as before most
will survive. But is it-worth the risk
for those who will not?
