In the meantime, 48 local residents signed a petition demanding that the university and the police put a stop to boisterous nighttime-activities by students in the park. The stage for confrontation was beautifully set. The radicalizing and polarizing process, already in high gear on the campus and in the surrounding community, was accelerated when police cleared the park and a work crew began fencing it in. A crowd of students, et al, marched on the park. The famous riot ensued.

Not only did this action radicalize and polarize people who had no connection with the university or the controversy, it terrorized scores of innocent nearby school children as well.
