## Rampton Protests Proposals To 'Dump' War Gas In Utah

**SALT LAKE CITY (UPI)** — Rampton, a town in the mountains west of Denver, has stored at the Rocky Mountain Arsenal at Denver, Colo., biological warfare (CBW) agents and biological warfare (CBW) agents.

## NAACP Aide Says Nixon 'Nullifies' Racial Gains

JACKSON, Miss. (UPI) — President Nixon's message on integration is coming through clearly: "If you're black, stay back," says a top official of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.

In the areas of school desegregation and voter registration, the Nixon administration has taken steps that could easily be made during the next decade, said Vernon Strother, Spottswood chairman of the NAACP board of directors.

"The encounters with sheriffs, the days in jail, the cracks of billy clubs, the sickening sight of hate in vain," Spottswood told the first general session of the NAACP's 40th national convention.

However, Spottswood expressed hope the trend was only temporary and rejected the temptation to "join with haters and the preachers of hate and violence."

The Nixon administration's sleight-of-hand is merely an interruption, a challenge to get up off the floor and fight for the black American's share of the American dream. It will be won, but in vain, Spottswood said. The clear message from Washington is, "If you are black, stay back," Spottswood told a wildly cheering audience at the convention's first mass meeting.
