## Most Wear On Car Tires Traceable

## To Improper-Wheel-Alignment

A tip to motorists who like to-play it -safe - keep your car on the straight and narrow. Proper wheel alignment will achieve that objective. When a tire, forcelully hits a chuckhole or similarly rough spot, the result ${ }^{-1}$ can be wheel leaving its straight and proper caurse. This, it turn, can result not enly in-costiy-tire-wear-witheh-can
create a salcty hazard but also can-result-in-damage to the car's frame.
Approximately 15 to 20 pet cent of tire wear on all of our nation's cars comes from improper whed alignment. Regu-
lar inspection of tires to make
certain wheels are rolling cor rectly not only will save motorists noties but will-reduce the chances of the car "reel ing"' toward a dangerous road shoulder or across a center lane, when the driver might $I$ ax A wheel affolina cian result in scuff tire damage within +2 mile of driving. Fouv drivers realize the tremendous wear on a tire that. for exarnple, "toes-in" or "toes-out," Each 10 miles of driving, with this kind of wheel misalignment, is equal to the tire wear which would come if the car were dragged sideways for 100 feet.

4. TIRE INFLATOR . . : The prossurized can ls casy to uso and will thelp you get to the nearest servlce station for a tire change. In fact: there are, thmea when it is downrlght unarite to try to change a tire yourself - traific condtions, weather,

5. SPARE FUSES . . Your auto store or. service station man can tell you how many of what type you will need. If you cant ingute out lase locaask your service man to help you. it can be a frustrating search on a rainy night when you have no lights.
6. FLares : . . When wou're in trouble on a dark road, reflector flares or emergency these are available at most huto supply stores. place yours 50 feet belind and ahead of your car to alert oncoming traffic of your predicatment.

ples-cars.
On your drlyeway or garnge floor. the same kind of dirty matks may be from your owt car, and this can be a house keeping problem - particuipr vested in yards of new. concrete vested in yards of new concrete or the diveway or to step in someone manages then it all over your brand
clean carpeting.
Taking a positive look at this messy business, a leak or drip is a danger slgnal. When cars are new, they don't drip erease or oil. At least, they, shouldn't But time-wear and vibrations take their foll on seals and. gaskets.
Think of all the parts that could be leaking: the engine or the differanting, tho power-ateer hag, a brake cyllnder, even a
shock absorber.

A spot of grease or ol under your parked car can mean you soon , Will have no lubrication on expenslye gears such as in the rear aule or transmission. A drip can indicate that raw asollne is getting on your en gine (right next io 15,000 volts of electrictiy). This kind of thing spreads car flires.
Your car sounds a four-alarm akerty in-fts own quiet way when the drips are leaking brake fluid. This usually drips
onto the inner surface of a tire; $s 0$ you may not see It unless you thappen to climb underneath your car to look. But your service station man can spot it when he has your car on the lift for service, which is n good reason, among others, for getting the car up on the ift from time to time.

age, on your driveway or your wall-to-wall carpeting, check in-
to thlngs. Put some newspaper or large pieces of an old sheet you were golng to tear up for rags anyway under your_car's regular parking place. See how much greasc.or oil accumulates overnight and approximately where the leak seems to be coming from.

WINTER HAZARDS GREATER Roads-present-more frazards to tires during winter months than duting warm - weather months. Foreign objects such as natls and glass are retained in the bulldup of lee and snow. For this reason, check winter tires carefully. and frequently for cuts or breaks. And be sure ou' have-n"spare tire-in your car's trunk.

## Think About Those Other Five Cars

At least five cars besides your own should concern you while driving.
They are the one ahead. the one behind; the one approaching in the opposing lane, the one ready to enter from a side street; and the one parked at the curb.
