## Better Ambulance Service Studied

TWIN FALLS — A series of radical advancements in emergency treatment of the ill or injured person, ranging from radio communication between ambulances and hospitals to aerial evacuation by helicopter, is in the works in Twin Falls.

Spurred by the Idaho Board of Health, the formation of the proposed Idaho Ambulance Association will insure that ambulance drivers and attendants are intensively trained in emergency treatment of the injured.

Radio links will be established between ambulances, law enforcement personnel and hospitals throughout Magic Valley, so that medical personnel can be advised of incoming emergency cases and can prepare operating rooms and equipment.

Clyce Edwards, owner of Magic Valley Ambulance Service, said today that the Idaho Ambulance Association has been suggested by the Idaho Board of Health to serve as an advisory board which will establish and enforce standards for both private and public ambulance services.

The organization would be accomplished under the new Highway Emergency Medical Service program, Edwards

said. Federal funds would be made available under the program to help local governmental agencies upgrade services, including the radio links with hospitals.

In Twin Falls, Edwards said, ambulance personnel are trained to administer first aid through advanced classes of the American Red Cross. Radio communications are provided between ambulances and law enforcement agencies.

In addition, helicopter service, when ordered by ambulance association members, would be provided at no cost through the Mountain Home Air Force Base.

Edwards said a meeting will be scheduled in the near future to consider formation of the association.

Other advisory board members and the groups they represent include R. L. Daley, Boise Idaho Safety Council; Paul Romrell, St. Anthony, Idaho Hospital Administrators; Leonard Ellis, Lewiston, government agency operated ambulances; Ed Summerman, Boise, Associated Idaho Cities; Jim Heath, Meridian, Idaho Jaycees; and Leroy Lindley, American Falls, Idaho Association of County Commissioners.

## Hearings Slated In Viet Massacre

FT. HOOD, Tex. (UPI)—Pretrial hearings for a soldier charged in the My Lai massacre of March 16, 1968, were scheduled to begin today with the defense planning to bring up motions ranging from subpoenaing top government officials to moving the trial to Vietnam.

The hearing for Sgt. David Mitchell was to have begun in June but was delayed while his civilian attorney, Ossie Brown, tried to have it moved to a civilian court.

Among the defense motions is a request to court martial subpoena President Nixon to testify for the defense. Brown

also wants subpoenas issued for Army Chief of Staff Gen. William C. Westmoreland, Army Secretary Stanley R. Resor and Defense Secretary Melvin R. Laird.

Another of Brown's motions would, if approved, change the location of the trial from the rolling hills of Central Texas to the jungles of Vietnam. Brown contends this would be preferable to relying on "two-year-old memories" to reconstruct what happened at the South Vietnamese village.

Brown also plans to contend pretrial publicity has made it impossible for Mitchell to receive a fair trial.

## Mayor Designates Citizenship Day

TWIN FALLS — Twin Falls Mayor Frank H. Feldman has proclaimed Thursday, Sept. 17, as "Citizenship Day" in Twin Falls.

His designation is in keeping with a federal proclamation by Congress, which "set aside the seventeenth day of September of each year as Citizenship Day in commemoration of the signing of the Constitution on Sept. 17, 1787," the mayor's proclamation said.

"The President of the United States of America has urged federal, state and local officials as well as all religious, civic,

educational and other interested organizations to make arrangements for impressive observations on that day to inspire all citizens to rededicate themselves to the service of their country and to the support and defense of the Constitution," the proclamation continues.

Mayor Feldman said that "I urge our citizens to respect our heritage of freedom and justice and help others to understand that it can be preserved only if we fulfill our personal obligations to citizenship in the United States of America."

## Home-Baked Butter Cake Has Memory-Making Flavor

When people yearn for "a piece of real cake" they're talking about home-baked. And when they begin to reminisce about mouth-melting cakes they've eaten, chances are they mean butter cakes. Nothing else produces quite the same memory-making flavor.

Bake up a memory yourself soon — a real butter cake. Make it in a bundt pan and marble it with a combination of light and dark batter. Or choose a spice cake, filled with luscious whipped cream and topped with peach slices, glazed for glamour. Or try a new kind of Upside-Down Cake — made with cranberries. Any one of them is a special compliment to your guests, a gala touch for your gathering. And think of the pride and pleasure you'll feel when you turn out one of these cakes.

Peach Crowned Spice Cake is a real party cake with its glorious looks and taste. But surprise! — the recipe uses the easy one-bowl mixing method. With a butter cake you can mix and bake the cake a day ahead, then fill and frost before serving. Only butter keeps a cake moist, tender and flavorful the second and third day, just as on the first day of baking.

If your knowledge of how to use cranberries stops at cranberry sauce, it's high time you discovered flavorful Cranberry Upside-Down Cake which magically bakes on its own "frosting" — so attractive and colorful. Serve the still-warm cake with the pleasing contrast of cool, sweetened whipped cream — or with rich Rum Hard Sauce.

A real beauty of a cake, elegant in its simplicity, is Marbled Bundt Cake. Its texture is similar to that of pound cake and, like a pound cake, its flavor depends on butter. The bundt pan makes a cake so handsome it can stand alone — but you can add a simple confectioners sugar glaze, if you like.

Bake one of these recipes — and next time people recall a wonderful cake they've tasted, it may be you — they're talking about!

### MARBLED BUNDT CAKE

- 1 cups (2 sticks) butter
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 4 egg yolks
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 3 cups sifted cake flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup milk
- 4 egg whites
- 1 square (1 oz.) unsweetened chocolate, melted and cooled

In a large mixing bowl cream butter; gradually add sugar and beat until light and fluffy. Add egg yolks one at a time beating thoroughly after each addition. Blend in vanilla. Sift together flour, baking powder and salt; add to creamed mixture alternately with milk beginning and ending with dry ingredients. Beat egg whites until soft peaks form; fold into batter. Divide batter in half; fold chocolate into one-half. Alternate light and dark batters by spoonful in a buttered 10 x 3 1/4 inch bundt pan; run wide knife through batter. Bake in a preheated 325 degree oven 45-60 minutes. Allow to stand 10 minutes on wire rack. Remove to wire rack to cool completely.

### PEACH CROWNED SPICE CAKE

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, softened
- 1 1/4 cups cake flour
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves

- 1-3 cup firmly packed light brown sugar
- 1/4 cup buttermilk
- 2 eggs

### PEACH SAUCE

- 1 can (1 lb. 14 oz.) sliced cling peaches
- 1-3 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
- Dash of cloves
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 cup whipping cream
- 2 tablespoons confectioners sugar

To prepare Spice Cake: In a large mixing bowl beat butter until creamy. Sift together flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, nutmeg and cloves; add to mixing bowl along with brown sugar and buttermilk. At low speed of mixer, beat until dry ingredients are moistened; then beat at medium speed for 2 minutes. Add eggs and beat 2 additional minutes. Turn into buttered 8-inch square pan. Bake in a preheated 350 degree oven 30-35 minutes. Allow to stand 5 minutes; turn onto wire rack to cool. Meanwhile, prepare Peach Sauce: Drain peaches reserving syrup; add sufficient water, if necessary, to make 1 1/2 cups.

In a 1-quart saucepan combine sugar, cornstarch, cinnamon, nutmeg and cloves; gradually add reserved syrup. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until thickened. Cook 2 additional minutes. Add butter and stir until butter is melted; stir in lemon juice. To serve: Split cake in two layers. Whip cream; add confectioners sugar. Spread on bottom cake half. Set aside half of the peach slices; layer remaining slices on whipped cream. Cover with top half of cake. Arrange reserved peach slices on top of cake; drizzle sauce over top to glaze peaches. Cut into squares and serve with remaining sauce. Makes 9-12 servings.

### CRANBERRY UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE

- 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) butter
- 1/2 cup firmly packed light brown sugar
- 1 1/2 cups cranberries, halved
- 1/4 cup chopped walnuts
- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 1/4 cups regular all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup milk

In oven-proof 10-inch skillet melt 1/4 cup butter; sprinkle brown sugar evenly over bottom. Add cranberries and nuts; set aside. In a small mixing bowl cream 1/2 cup butter; gradually add sugar and beat until light and fluffy. Add egg and beat thoroughly. Sift together flour, baking powder and salt; add to creamed mixture alternately with milk, beginning and ending with dry ingredients. Spread evenly over cranberries. Bake in a preheated 350 degree oven 35-40 minutes. Invert immediately onto serving plate. Serve warm topped with Rum Hard Sauce or sweetened whipped cream. Makes 10-12 servings.

### RUM HARD SAUCE

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter
- 1 1/4 cups confectioners sugar
- 1 tablespoon hot water
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 teaspoon rum extract
- Dash of salt

In a small mixing bowl cream butter; gradually add sugar and beat until light and fluffy. Beat in water, vanilla and rum extracts and salt. Chill.

#### SNICKERDOODLES

- 1 cup soft shortening
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 3/4 cups flour
- 2 teaspoons cream of tartar
- 1 teaspoon soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Pre-heat oven to 400 degrees. Mix shortening, sugar and eggs together thoroughly. Sift flour, cream of tartar, soda and salt together. Add to first mixture. Chill dough. Roll into balls the size of small walnuts, then roll in a mixture of four tablespoons sugar, and two teaspoons cinnamon. Place about two inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake eight to 10 minutes until lightly browned.

These cookies puff up then flatten to out with crinkled tops. Makes five dozen.

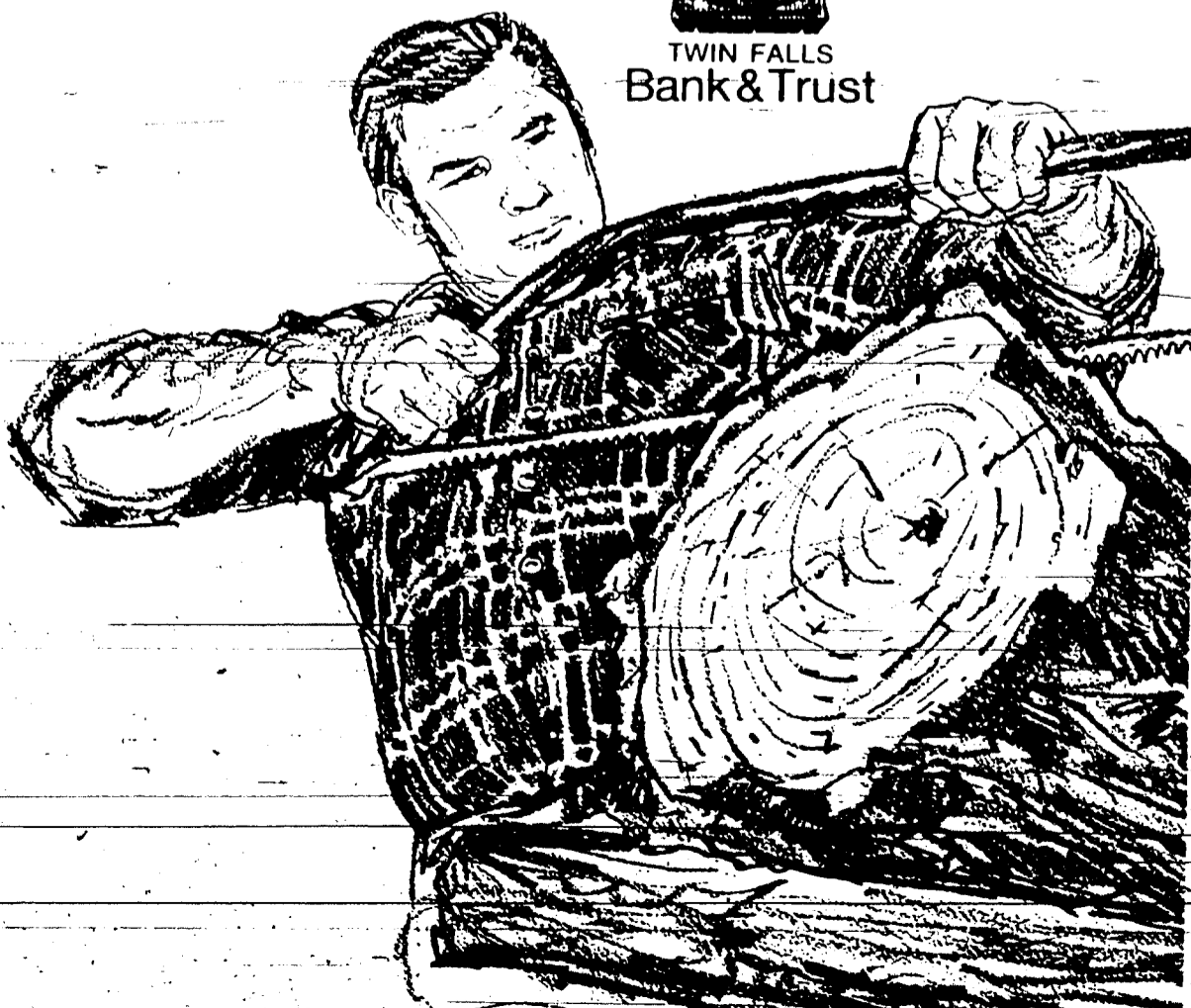

# Keith Lincoln Added To Idaho Grid Staff

SPOKANE (UPI) — The University of Idaho dropped a bomb on Washington State University officials at the weekly meeting of the Inland Empire sportswriters and broadcasters Monday when it announced the signing of Keith Lincoln, former WSU star, as an assistant football coach.
