STANFORD, Calif., AP — Columbine High students were allowed back inside Monday for the first time since the bloodbath six weeks ago to increase backpacks and other belongings since last October when they were first there.

Welfare-to-work isn't working, critics say

"This is disappointing news considering it seemed as if they were finally getting these things working," said Robert L. Taylor, director of the Center for Social Policy Studies at the University of California, San Diego.

Other administration officials are saying Congress is not doing enough to make the program work. The program was supposed to help welfare recipients find jobs by providing them with training and job placement services.

The administration also is saying an additional \$1 billion in 1996 for social welfare programs. Congress has approved \$1 billion for welfare reform.

"We're already not going to get more money into it because of the budget," said Stephen J. Lippman, director of the Center for Social Policy Studies at the University of California, San Diego.
