## Idaho Congressman Asks for Details of Roosevelt, Churchill Program

BOISE, Aug. 18 (AP)—Representative Henry C. Dworshak (R-Idaho) said today that he expects the United States and the British congress should obtain from President Roosevelt details of the joint program evolved by the chief executive and Prime Minister Churchill at Great Britain's war cabinet meeting.

Attending the annual convention of the Idaho Department, American Legion, the congressman made the statement in interview.

"In view of the repeated pledges and assurances of our president not to send our boys to fight on foreign soil a large number of congressmen believe these pledges will be kept and although there have been some developments taking us almost into the war, the preponderance of sentiment in the house is opposed to our country becoming an active belligerent," he said.

# BLACK SEA RULE COAL FOR REICH

## Transportation Held Key to Value of Newly Won Territory

The German capture of Nikolayev and encirclement of Odessa mean that the Nazis are a bit closer to controlling the Black sea. It is clear, however, that the key to their success will be nearer their objective of setting up a blockade—"new Berlin" in Europe.

While the German press hails the occupation of the iron ore region as a strategic blow to Russia, official Berlin is presumably under no illusions that access to the Ukraine's riches can profit the Reich economically until some line of communication is opened to sea tankers and other cargo ships.

Of immediate importance therefore is the degree to which the Soviet naval forces have been weakened by loss of the Nikolayev base. That has not yet been disclosed.

Transportation is a bottleneck in the effort to set up a land-dominated, self-sufficient Europe. Water routes, which include the 700-mile long with the Danube, the Baltic and ultimately the Mediterranean, are vital to that flow as the overland, war-damaged railroads.

The bulk of approximately seven million barrels of oil is produced in the area, which is credited with having supplied the bulk of the fuel for the German war effort by way of the Black sea. It is expected that every drop was shipped by tankers across the Black sea to Constantinople, Rumania's chief port, or to nearby points, and thence up the Danube.

Belief that control of the Mediterranean is essential to any lasting triumph figures in the prediction made to congress by General George C. Marshall that the next Nazi campaign would be an attempt to break Britain's dominance of this great maritime highway.

"Should Germany some day be able to ship its oil to Rumania, through and out from the Black sea, through the Mediterranean to Marseille, Tripoli and France, or distribution by rail from those ports, and supplying Europe would be solved."

## Proposed Consolidation of Headquarters Brings Protest

WASHINGTON, Aug. 18 (AP)—An attempt to consolidate the Civilian Conservation Corps district headquarters at Salt Lake City, Utah, and Boise, Idaho, with the CCC district office at Pocatello, Idaho, and jointly remove them to Utah and Idaho members of congress.

# McCarran Scores In Mine Tax Fight

WASHINGTON, Aug. 19 (AP)—Senator McCarran (D-Nev.) said today that the OPM had agreed to his request for a study on the desirability of exemptions from the excess profits tax should continue to be made in the case of strategic metal production.

McCarran made OPM's decision known when he appeared before a senate finance committee to urge restoration of the exemption in the house approved 1941 revenue bill (HR. 8417) now under consideration by the committee. The bill, which would eliminate the exemptions.
