A six-man jury in probate court in Twin Falls yesterday was unable to agree whether "P. O. Defense attorney, W. L. Dunn, offered an evidence but argued the case had failed to prove charges against the accused man. Preliminary to the trial, the defendant's attorney had not appeared, had been ordered by the court to appear.

State witnesses included Neil Howard, 22, of Twin Falls, former driver of the car involved in the wreck, and Duane Christian, Twin Falls youth who was riding in the back.

Their testimony was that Neil had been drinking, that he rode into Howard's car without invitation; that a tire blew out as Howard was driving under the influence of alcohol; that he then grabbed the wheel.

The accident occurred last August at a mile and a half north of the Washington school, on highway 31. The car owner had just pleaded guilty to being intoxicated on the highway and paid \$25 fine.

# RANGERS APPLY FOR INSURANCE

### Requests Arrive at AAA Unit for 1942 Crop Coverage

Now being received daily at the Twin Falls county AAA office are applications from Twin Falls county wheat growers for federal all-risk crop insurance on their 1942 crop, according to Royzen Green, member of the county AAA committee in charge of crop insurance.

Little more than a week remains in which to make up for the crop to be applied for. Farmers who will now apply winter wheat at all for 1942 must take out insurance now in order to protect against loss of the crop to be planted here. Winter wheat application deadline is August 31, 1942, the official date.

Green stated that this year crop insurance more important than ever. They make the bag of a crop grower that is not insured. It is for wheat doesn't mean anything to those who make up crop failures, he declared.

The cost and coverage of the insurance is based on the wheat's production history of the individual farmer, with credits set up to allow any farmer to get a low rate of insurance by paying in insurance premiums when he has a good crop. Each farmer must pay a small amount of premium for next year. If they have a poor crop, the law allows premium at once. Premiums are paid in terms of the market price of wheat and under the provisions of the 1942 crop insurance program, may be paid any time before August 31, 1942.
