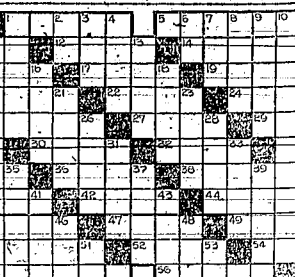

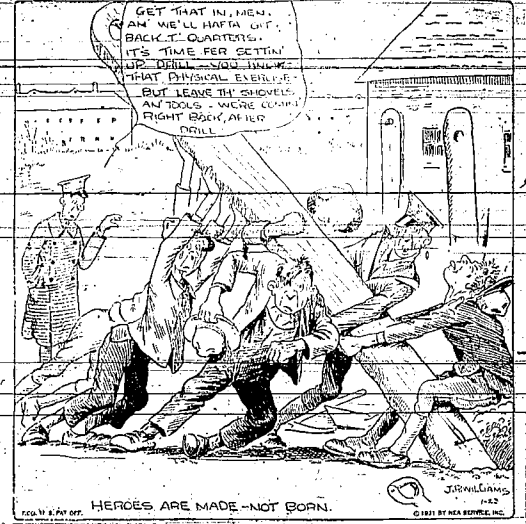
Trend of Wickersham Commission's Findings Pleas as Father of Prohibition

Editor's Note: Andrew J. Volstead, author of the prohibition enforcement act, has written the following article exclusively for this United States publication. It shows the recommendations of the Wickersham commission.
