Laguardia Proposal In Power Fight Gets Rejection in House

New York Representative Fails to Keep Disputed Men from Receiving Their Salaries

WASHINGTON, Jan. 27 (UP)—Rep. Laguardia, Republican, New York, today threw the contest over the President's appointments in the federal government into the House when he attached an amendment to the appropriation bill providing funds for the power commission, specifying that none of the money should be used to pay the salaries of the three commissioners involved in the dispute.

The commissioners are George Otis Smith, Marcel Grand and Claude L. Draper. Their nominations once were approved by the Senate but since then Smith has resigned and the President to resubmit the nominations. 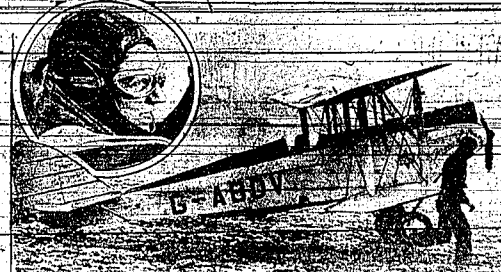

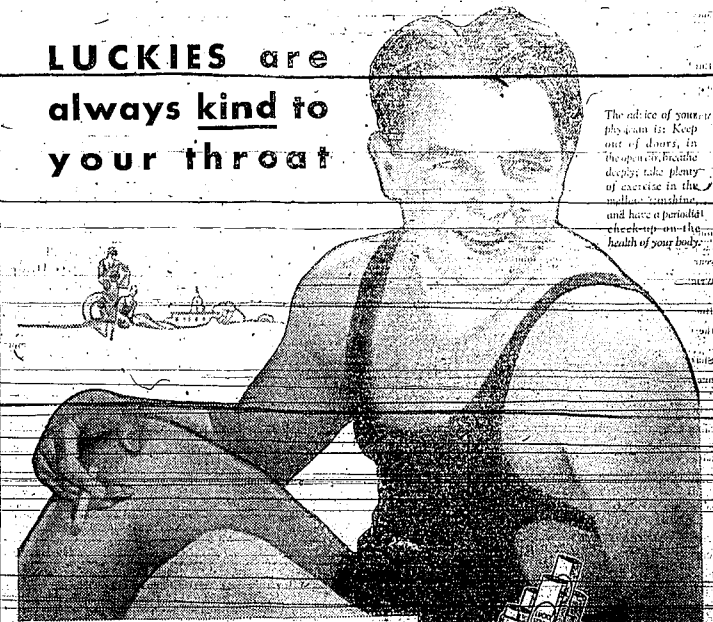

THE GASOLINE TAX

A NEWSPAPER writer recently pointed out that the average American motorist pays no less than \$18 a year in gasoline taxes. If this sum were collected in a lump, the motorist would kick like a mule, but it is taken from him painlessly, and he hardly so notices it.

The average tax is four cents a gallon—a sales tax on each gallon of about 25 cents. If the tax were levied in daily use were taxed at that rate the country would become angrily vocal in protest.

Perhaps this is chiefly because the money is used to build roads. Every motorist wants road yards, and the justice of making automobile owners pay for the payments on which they ride is obvious.

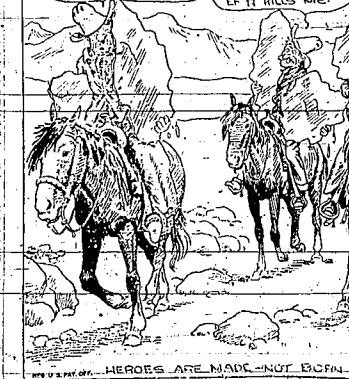

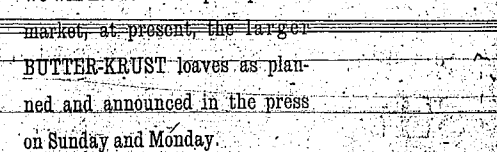
