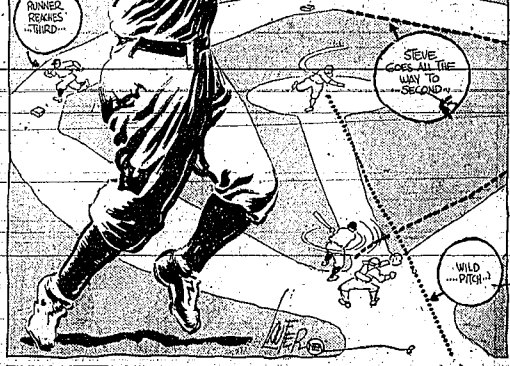

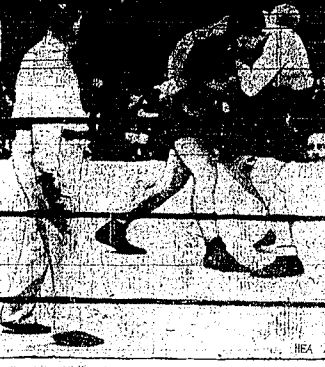

GOVERNOR ROSS is to be commended for his insistence that the legislature do something definite to remedy the tax burden in Idaho. He has called a special session of the legislature for that very purpose and is insisting that tax relief become a definite thing instead of only something to be talked about.

There are those who only see the political aspect of the situation—who, for instance, would peddle the old whey that in some unaccountable manner Governor Ross might be held responsible for the fiasco of the twenty-first session and who in the next breath would ask the kind indulgence of the public in passing judgment on the legislative branch. That is the typical partisan reaction.

What is needed in building sound public opinion is not so much ribald criticism of our governmental branches, but praise. Where gross injustice is worked, or where offenses are patent, then the press as well as the public is justified in criticism whether it is constructive or not.

Now the legislature has its opportunity to prove whether it is only a group of warring factions, each seeking to take some advantage of the other; whether its members are sincere in their expressed hope that they shall have contributed definitely to the benefit of the state and its people or whether its bid for fame shall depend entirely on its ability to have overruled the Governor's veto on the 90-day divorce bill.

Just as Governor Ross is redeeming his pledges made to the people of Idaho, it is to be hoped that the legislature in this special session will also redeem itself in public estimation.
